SPOTLIGHT: SIMULATION RESEARCH



Partnering with local EMS agencies to conduct field simulations to promote pediatric safety

OHSU researchers, state EMS-C, and Multnomah county EMS partnered to conduct simulations of children's emergencies in preparation for upcoming field simulations for the Children's Safety Initiative (<http://www.ohsu.edu/ems-c>). The Children's Safety Initiative is a large, 5-year NICHD funded patient safety study to describe and understand challenges that occur during emergency calls involving children in the prehospital setting. The study includes focus groups, a national Delphi survey, chart review, and concludes with simulations involving fire and transporting EMS agencies to understand the human, technology, and process factors that lead to safety events.
