- Regular Updates (20 minutes)
- Student Newsletter Committee (Vijay Patel): There is a new Pulse edition that has just come out. Ht articles and pictures are fantastic. Look for a current issue near you at your specific school.
- Student Health Advisory Group (Derek Musashe):Student health center construction will start on May 16th. It is on schedule for completion by the beginning of the academic start of the year.
  - dependants need to be re-enrolled every year.

- There is a push to have a tutorial for all the insurance information. How it all works, who to talk to for particular case, to confer more information to entering students.

- Student Center Planning Committee (Karen Seresun):
  - Construction has started and in under way. They are making good progress and are on tract with the schedule. Most everything is lined up. The architect of project has posted the plans of the final project and can be seen in the Student Center. Scheduled to finish in the second week in July.   - March Wellness (Amber, Director; Joan Feraco):
  - A lot of students were interested in finding out about fees for classes, information about free two and a half hour parking, and how to sign your spouse up for a membership.
- Library (Laura Zeigen): Had a booth for the Student Research Forum.
  - AccessMedicine is similar to PubMed except for textbooks- There are now a total of 13 licenses that allows you to login to access medicine. This is an increase of 5 licenses which will allow 5 more people to be on Access Medicine simultaneously.
  - The Library has intentions to provide services to students wherever they are and wherever it is needed.
