- **Welcome/Food/Drinks** (10 minutes)
- **Approval of Past Minutes** (1 minute): There was a first and second motion and full approval of past meeting minutes
- **Funding Request** (10 minutes): No funding requests were presented to the council.
- **Campus Store Vacancy Survey** (5 minutes): SC proposals for the vacant space are due by January 15<sup>th</sup> to the provost office. SC will formulate a list of possibilities to propose to the student body. Ideas from past meetings include a bar/student lounge (outside vendor), conference room, and student study space with a printer. A survey will be sent out to the student body.
- **30<sup>th</sup> Annual Student Research Forum; May 20-24** (Allison Anacker): This year Kelly Chacon (chaconk@ebs.ogi.edu) will be the student rep. She is looking for input from students from all programs on what they would like to see at research week. They are looking for students to be part of a committee for this event. They would like to keep a focus on students. A member of the council expressed how much he has appreciated the student focus in the past and is hoping that this will continue to be a student ran event.
- **OHSU Blazer Night** (Tarah Authier): This years OHSU blazer night is being planned for the 26<sup>th</sup> of January against the LA Clippers. An All-Hill email/post will be sent out with more details on this event. They are hoping to have screening tables from each school present at the game. SC discussed whether or not screening tables should be present this year. One member suggested that instead of having different and specific tables from each school there that we should have tables with teams of students from different programs.
- **All-Hill Ski Trip** (Nate Risley): Fliers were given to members present at the meeting in order to distribute them to all the schools. The event will be January 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Prices for this event are set for \$55 for OHSU students and \$65 for OHSU Student Guests. There are 6, 8, 10, 12, and 14 person cabins. There will be a All-Hill sponsored party on Saturday Night with food and

beverages provided. Nick Brady will be added as a contact for Nursing students. Tarah Authier will be the second contact for pharmacy and Derek Musache will be added as the second contact for grad. New this year are student waivers that need to be filled out, signed, and collected for students and guests. Regulation of making sure students sign the waivers was discussed. An email will be sent out to the newly added student contacts with more information. Forms will need to be collected by December 10<sup>th</sup>.
