




Participating in OHSU's Project ECHO from a Web Browser

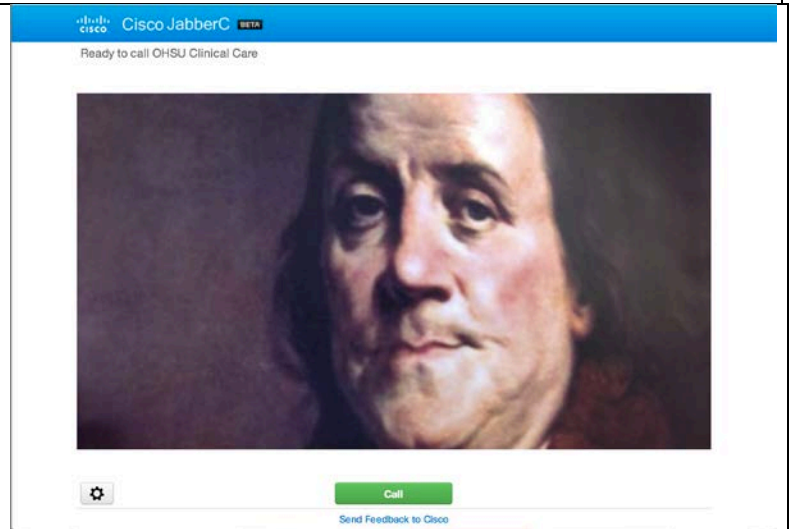
System Requirements	
Computer:	Windows or Macintosh computer built within last five years. Webcam, Microphone and Headphones.
Browser:	Supported Browsers: Mozilla Firefox (preferred), Google Chrome, Apple Safari, Microsoft Internet Explorer 9+.
Internet Requirement:	Internet connection with a minimum bandwidth of 768kbps upstream and downstream. Cable or DSL Preferred. A dial-up modem will not work.
Installation & Testing	
<p>When you are ready to install the Project ECHO video tool, enter the following URL into your browser to begin installation:</p> <p>https://jabberlink.ohsu.edu/call/echosetup</p>	
<p>Once you have clicked the "Install" button, your computer will download a file. Once the download is finished, run the file to begin the installation (if it didn't already start automatically).</p>	
<p>When opening the plug-in for the first time, your browser may ask for your permission to open the file. Select "Always run on this site"</p> 	<p>Depending on which browser you're using, the prompt may vary slightly from above.</p>

Once confirmed, the browser plug-in setup will be finalized and you should be ready to move on to testing.

When started for the first time, the video tool prompts you to configure your camera, microphone and headphone volume. Make sure that you see an image in the camera preview window, hear the test music on your speakers and adjust your microphone level to the recommended range.

Once the page has loaded you will be presented with a screen displaying your camera's video.

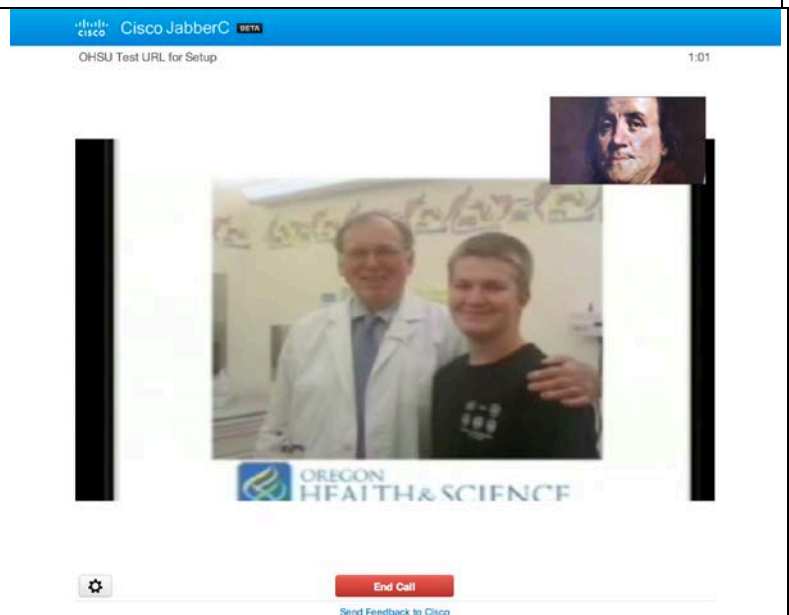
You can make a test call by clicking the green "Call" button.



Once connected, you should be able to view the OHSU video test site.

When you are finished with your test click the "End Call" button to disconnect.

The quality should look and sound similar to a YouTube video.



You can repeat these steps at anytime if you wish to re-test your video capabilities again in the future

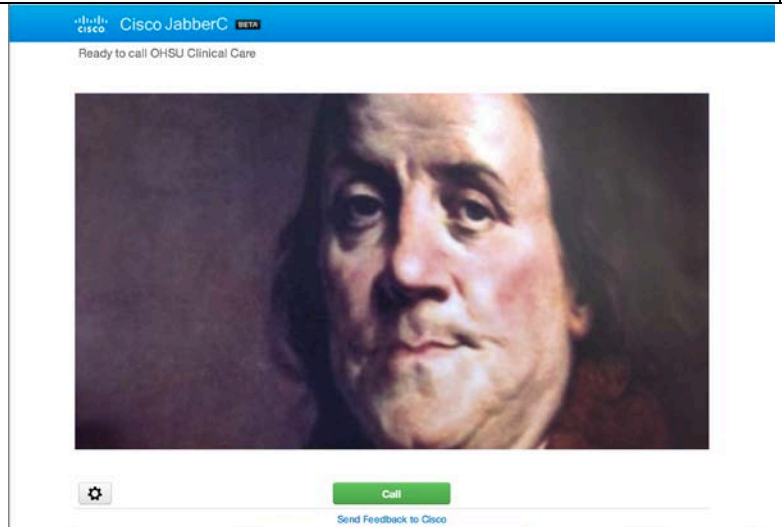
OHSU's Project ECHO for Web Participants

When you are ready to join the Project ECHO meeting, open the following URL in your web browser:

Once the page has loaded, you will be presented with a screen displaying your camera's video.

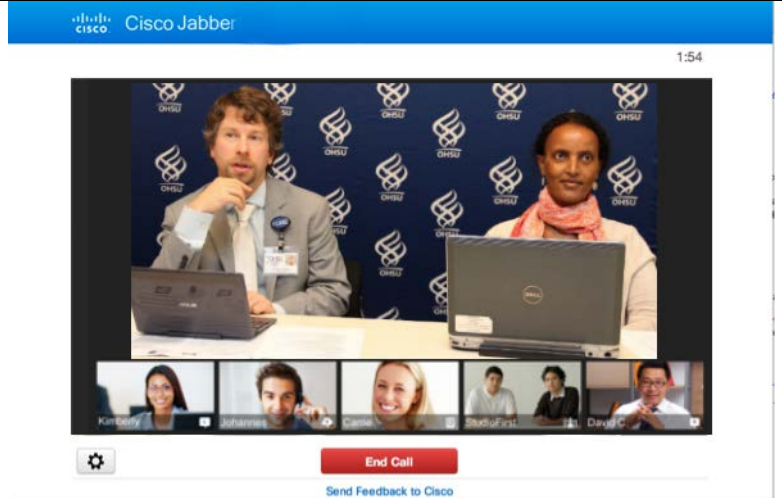
You can join the meeting by clicking the green "Call" button.



Once connected, you should see the remote sites on your screen.

(If you are the first to connect, you will see a mirror image of yourself until another video participant joins the conference.)

When the meeting has concluded, click the "End Call" button to disconnect.

Best Practices / Video Etiquette

Good Composition: Use your self-view window to make sure that your face fits nicely in your video.

Mute your Microphone: Make sure to keep your microphone muted when you're not speaking

Be Prepared: Test ahead of time and connect early to check connection and to verify audio and video
