### Driving Directions

**From the south via I-5** take exit 299A (43/26 East Ross Island Bridge/Macadam). At first stop light, turn right onto SW Curry. Turn left onto SW Bond and right onto SW Whitaker to enter the surface lot.

**From the north via 1-5** as you cross the river on the Marquam Bridge, stay in the far right lane. Take exit 299A to 43/Lake Oswego/Macadam. As you exit move to the middle lane. Follow the signs to "South Waterfront". As the road curves to the left, stay to the left. At the light, turn left onto SW Macadam. Turn right onto SW Curry. Turn left onto SW Bond and right onto SW Whitaker to enter the surface lot.

## CONFERENCE DESCRIPTION

This conference will provide a state-of-the-art update on prevention and early detection of prostate cancer, treatment of localized prostate cancer, medical management of advanced prostate cancer, and current status of knowledge about the role of nutrition in prostate cancer. In addition, the program will provide insights into coping with the diagnosis of prostate cancer and address sexuality in prostate cancer survivors. This program will include ample opportunities for audience participation. Highlights of recent scientific progress and a survey of current clinical trials likely to change the standard care in the coming years will be prominently featured.
