#### Public Transportation

#### Driving Directions

**From the south via I-5** take exit 299A. At first stop light, turn right onto SW Curry. Turn left onto SW Bond and right onto SW Whitaker to enter the surface lot.

**From the north via I-5** as you cross the river on the Marquam Bridge, stay in the far right lane. Take exit 299A to 43/Lake Oswego/Macadam. As you exit move to the middle lane. Follow the signs to "South Waterfront". As the road curves to the left, stay to the left. At the light, turn left onto SW Macadam. Turn right onto SW Curry. Turn left onto SW Bond and right onto SW Whitaker to enter the surface lot.
