FAILURE TO THRIVE

CBC with differential
Complete metabolic panel
Total IgA
IgA for tissue transglutaminase (TTG)
Thyroid stimulating hormone (TSH)
Stool stain for fat – qualitative

PERSISTENT VOMTING/ GE REFLUX

Upper GI (X-ray with barium) to the
Ligament of Treitz to evaluate for malrotation

ABDOMINAL PAIN

ESR and C-Reactive Protein (CRP)
CBC with differential
Complete metabolic panel
Lipase
Iga Total
IgA for Tissue Transglutaminase (TTG)
Stool Calprotectin (inflammatory marker)

Urine pregnancy screen if past menarche

NAUSEA

CBC with differential
Complete Metabolic Panel
Lipase
ESR
Urine pregnancy screen if past menarche

Persistent DIARRHEA (> 3 weeks)

CBC with differential
Complete metabolic panel
ESR and /or CRP
Total IgA
IgA for Tissue Transglutaminase (TTG)

Stool for: culture including yersinia, shigella,
salmonella, campylobacter, e. coli 0157:h7

Stool also for: O and P
Giardia antigen
Calprotectin
Fat stain – qualitative
Cryptosporidium

BLOOD IN STOOLS – BABY

Stool culture and calprotectin
C. difficile if infant > 6 mo. of age
CBC with differential

BLOOD IN STOOL – KIDS

CBC with differential
ESR and CRP
Complete Metabolic Panel
Stool for: Calprotectin and WBC
Culture including yersinia, salmonella,
shigella, e. coli, campylobacter
C. difficile toxins A and B or PCR

If bleeding is brisk, get Meckel's scan ASAP with IV Zantac or Pepcid to enhance, and call pediatric surgery ASAP.
