Public Transportation

We encourage all of our applicants to use public transportation, as it is an easy cost effective way to get around town. TriMet's MAX (Light Rail) Red Line is a great way to get to and from Portland International Airport (PDX). The trip between the airport and downtown takes about 38 minutes and requires an All-Zone fare, which can be purchased for \$4.75 and is good all day. Ticket Machines are located at each station and take debit, credit, or coins. Trains run about every 15 minutes most of the day, and you can easily roll your luggage on board.



OHSU has an Aerial Tram that runs from the waterfront of Downtown Portland up to our campus which sits on a hill. The Aerial Tram is free to all applicants at OHSU, since we will send you a pass ahead of time. TriMet riders may ride the bus or MAX downtown and transfer to the Portland Streetcar, which will take you to the tram. TriMet bus and MAX schedules can be accessed online at www.trimet.org. The closest Streetcar stop to the downtown transit mall is at S.W. Fifth and Market. The Streetcar and Tram both accommodate bikes and mobility devices. Schedules and fare information are available online at www.portlandstreetcar.org. Please note that the tram has limited space. If you have numerous pieces of luggage you most likely will need to leave it with the hotel concierge.

Suggested Hotel Options for OHSU Pediatric Applicants

1. The Avalon Hotel & Spa - 0455 SW Hamilton Court - Portland – 1.888.556.4402

On the banks of the Willamette River, just minutes from downtown Portland, the Avalon is a luxurious boutique hotel offering tranquil surroundings and amenities. Free Internet access. Not far from the street car and OHSU tram. The OHSU rate for Hillside or Riverside room is \$109 per night. Book by phone only and ask for “OHSU Rate”. www.avalonhotelandspa.com

2. Hilton - 921 SW Sixth Avenue - Portland - 503.226.1611

The Hilton Portland & Executive Tower hotel in Portland, the largest hotel in the state, consists of two separate buildings and combined offers [782 guest rooms](#) and two restaurants. It is located one block off the Max line (light rail system from the airport). The OHSU room rate is \$99 during November and December. hilton.com

3. Residence Inn by Marriott @ Riverplace - 2115 SW River Parkway - Portland - 503.552.9500

Located downtown near the waterfront and on the Portland streetcar line, just one stop away from the OHSU tram. Complimentary shuttle within a five-mile radius of the hotel, including OHSU. Also offered are a complimentary full, hot breakfast, free high-speed Internet access, and a fully equipped kitchen in every suite. Indoor pool, spa, 24-hour exercise facility, and onsite laundry. The OHSU rate is \$139. The front desk will need evidence of OHSU visit (printed interview e-mail, for example). 4. Inn at Marquam Hill – 3412 SW 13th Avenue - Portland - 503.223.6617

Located in a quiet residential neighborhood within walking distance of OHSU, this bed and breakfast's mission is to provide guests with a relaxing environment. They cater to OHSU visitors and guests. Each room shares a bathroom with one other room. The rooms are furnished with color cable TV, drawer and closet space, large windows and queen beds. Made to order breakfasts are also served. \$89 - \$105 a night.

5. Hotel Modera - 515 SW Clay - Portland – 1.877.484.1084

Located downtown near Portland State University, this hip, modern hotel offers a luxe lobby and a courtyard with gorgeous landscaping and fire pits. Spacious rooms have pillow-top beds, down blankets, and large picture windows. Amenities include free wireless internet, complimentary passes to 24-Hour Fitness, iPod docking stereo/alarm clocks, LCD flat-screen TVs, in-room mini refrigerators and safes, and a newspaper delivered to your door. The streetcar line is just a few blocks away, and the #8 bus to OHSU picks up around the corner. The OHSU rate ranges by room and night but is in the range of \$119-\$139. Book by phone only and ask for "OHSU Rate".

6. Heathman Hotel - 1001 Southwest Broadway - Portland - 503.241.4100

This sophisticated boutique hotel offers luxurious accommodations which include: high-speed internet, a French press coffee and tea in each room and award-winning service. They also have a very nice restaurant. It is located 3-4 blocks from the Max Light Rail system. They offer an OHSU rate of \$155 for a king deluxe room and \$149 for a queen room. heathmanportland.com

7. Governor Hotel - 614 Southwest 11th Avenue - Portland - 503.224.3400

This luxury hotel boasts 100 years of superb hospitality and service. The newly remodeled Governor is one of the true historic landmarks of the Pacific Northwest — perfectly combining historical ambiance and modern convenience. The Downtown Streetcar is right outside and the Max Light Rail system is one block away. Their OHSU rate varies by room and night, but ranges between \$119-\$139. governorhotel.com

8. The Mark Spencer Hotel - 409 SW 11th Ave & Stark St – Portland – 1.800.548.3934

A charming hotel with European hospitality located downtown, just steps from galleries, boutiques, restaurants, and the street car line. OHSU rate is \$92-

\$101 Per Night for a queen plus taxes. They offer continental breakfast, daily afternoon tea, fully equipped kitchens, and complimentary wireless internet. Parking available for an additional \$16 per night. Book by phone only and ask for "OHSU Rate". www.markspencer.com

9. **Ace Hotel - 1022 SW Stark - Portland - 503.228.2277**

A boutique hotel in downtown, just two blocks from The Pearl district and across the street from world-famous Powell's Books. Each room is unique in design and has a private bath with either a stand-up shower or clawfoot tub. Rooms also have 18" flat-screen TVs and complementary Wi-Fi access. The OHSU rate is \$139 (not including taxes) for a Standard Front or Standard Back room or VIP 10% off any other room with a normal price range of \$140-\$175. 10. **Benson Hotel - 309 Southwest Broadway - Portland - 503.228.2000**

The Benson Hotel is a 287 room historic hotel building in downtown Portland. It has a reputation as one of Portland's finest hotels. It has an OHSU rate of \$129. bensonhotel.com

11. **Park Lane Suites - 809 SW King Avenue - Portland - 503.226.6288**

An informal, yet stylish, inn offering small suite accommodations. Located in the residential neighborhood of Nob Hill, the hotel is just 3 ½ blocks from the MAX light rail line and within walking distance of NW 21st and 23rd streets. The OHSU preferred rate ranges from \$59-\$69 for a single queen room a night to \$89-\$99 for a queen suite room a night. Amenities include a kitchen in each room, free parking, on-site laundry, and complimentary continental breakfast. Book by phone only and ask for "OHSU Rate". www.parklanesuites.com

12. **Inn@Northrup Station - 2025 NW Northrup Street - Portland - 1.800.224.1180**

A modern, very hip, all-suites inn that offers an applicant rate of 10% off best available rate per night (average \$124-\$164). Continental breakfast, parking, and streetcar tickets are included. In heart of famous NW 21st & 23rd street districts amongst boutiques, cafes, brewpubs, and a variety of unique restaurants. Book by phone only and ask for "OHSU Applicant Rate". www.northrupstation.com

Most transportation providers serve downtown Portland, which is approximately 20-40 minutes from Portland International Airport.

DRIVING TO MARQUAM HILL – DO NOT DEPEND ON A GPS

From Lake Oswego/Sellwood Bridge area

- Travel north on S.W. Macadam Avenue.
- Turn left onto S.W. Boundary Street.
- Proceed one block and turn right onto S.W. Corbett Avenue
- Turn left onto S.W. Hamilton Street.
- Turn right onto S.W. Barbur Boulevard and continue for approximately 2.5 miles.
- At the second light past the YMCA (on the left), make a sharp left turn onto S.W. Caruthers Street.
- Turn left at the second light onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
- Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

Alternative route from the Lake Oswego area

- Travel north on S.W. Boones Ferry Road.
- Turn left onto S.W. Terwilliger Boulevard.
- Turn right onto S.W. Barbur Boulevard and continue for approximately 2.5 miles.
- At the second light past the YMCA (on the left), make a sharp left turn onto S.W. Caruthers Street.
- Turn left at the second light onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
- Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

From the West

- Travel east on Hwy. 26/Sunset Hwy.
- Stay in the right lane and follow the signs to I-405 (Salem/The Dalles).
- After passing through the Vista Ridge tunnel, stay to the right as the freeway branches.
- Take the S.W. 6th Avenue exit.
- Turn right onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
- Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

From the East

- Travel west on I-84 to the juncture with I-5.
- Follow I-5 south toward Salem.
- As you cross the Marquam Bridge, merge into one of the two left lanes, following the signs to City Center/Beaverton.
- Take the S.W. 6th Avenue exit.
- Immediately move to the left lane and turn onto S.W. College Street (or the next possible street that allows a left turn.)
- Turn left onto S.W. Broadway Avenue and move to the right lane.
- Bear right onto S.W. 6th Avenue, following signs to OHSU.
- Follow the directions listed below to the clinic, hospital or building you are visiting.

From the South via I-5

- Travel north on I-5.
- Take exit 297 (Terwilliger Boulevard).
- Turn left at stop light onto S.W. Terwilliger Boulevard.
- Turn right onto S.W. Barbur Boulevard and continue for approximately 2.5 miles.
- At the second light past the YMCA, make a sharp left turn onto S.W. Caruthers Street.
- Turn left onto S.W. 6th Avenue.
- Follow hospital signs

From the South using S.W. Barbur Blvd.

- Travel north on S.W. Barbur Blvd.
- At the second light past the YMCA (on the left), make a sharp left turn onto S.W. Caruthers Street.
- At the second light, turn left onto S.W. 6th Avenue.

From the Southeast

- Travel north on S.E. McLoughlin Boulevard or west on S.E. Powell Boulevard.
- After crossing the Ross Island Bridge, take the City Center exit.
- Follow S.W. Corbett Avenue, staying in the left lane.
- S.W. Corbett will turn into S.W. Kelly, then into S.W. Arthur, and finally into S.W. Caruthers before ending at S.W. 6th Avenue.
- Turn left onto S.W. 6th Avenue.

From the North

- Travel south on I-5 toward Salem.
- As you cross the Marquam Bridge, merge into one of the two left lanes, following signs to City Center/Beaverton.

- Take the S.W. 6th Avenue exit
 - Immediately move to the left lane and turn onto S.W. College Street (or the next possible street that allows a left turn.)
 - Turn left onto S.W. Broadway and move to the right lane.
 - Bear right onto S.W. 6th Avenue, following the signs to OHSU.

From the Northwest

- Travel southeast on Hwy. 30 (St. Helens Road) toward City Center, following signs to I-405.
 - Take I-405 south.
 - Take the S.W. 6th Avenue exit.
 - Turn right on S.W. 6th Avenue, following the signs to OHSU.

- A campus parking pass can be reserved in your name and you can pick it up on the corner of 6th and Terwilliger. Once you arrive on campus, from Terwilliger, please turn right on to Campus Drive and proceed up the hill to Sam Jackson Park Road. Make a left turn and go up the hill to US Veterans Road where you will turn left and follow all the way around until it becomes Gaines Rd.
