Prostate cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer in U.S. men. Screening is important because it may detect cancer at an early treatable stage.

Who needs to be screened?

Men who are 40 - 75 should be screened annually.

Screening involves:

- Medical history questionnaire
- PSA blood test
- Digital rectal exam

Decrease your screening time

We highly encourage you to pre-register by calling 503 494-8505 and mention the free prostate cancer screening. This will expedite your screening process and insure you receive your test results. If you have previously received healthcare from OHSU, you do not need to pre-register.
