

Thank you for your interest in the Oregon Rural Scholars Program (ORSP). This program is intended for OHSU medical students who are serious about pursuing a rural career in a primary care discipline (Family Medicine, Pediatrics, General Internal Medicine, General Surgery, or General Psychiatry). There are 15 slots available to qualified MD candidates, with priority given to those who expect to graduate in 2020. Students accepted into the program will complete twelve consecutive weeks in a single practice in rural Oregon, along with other supplemental rural curriculum and mentoring.

The ORSP experience will satisfy the School of Medicine requirements for rural experience and continuity experience. With departmental approval, it may also satisfy the core requirement of a primary care discipline (e.g. Family Medicine core, Psychiatry core).
