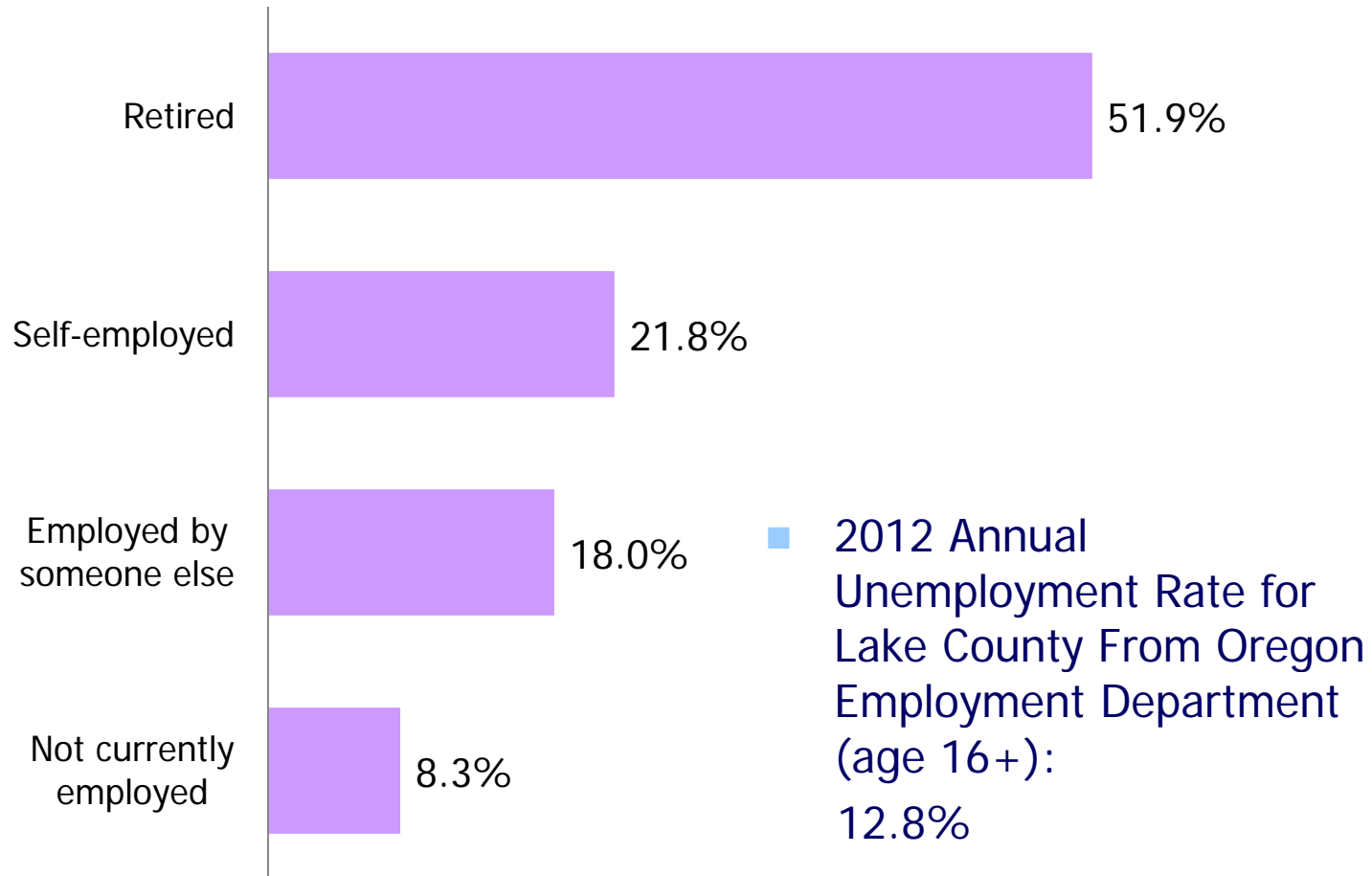
# 33. What year were you born? (Age of Respondents)



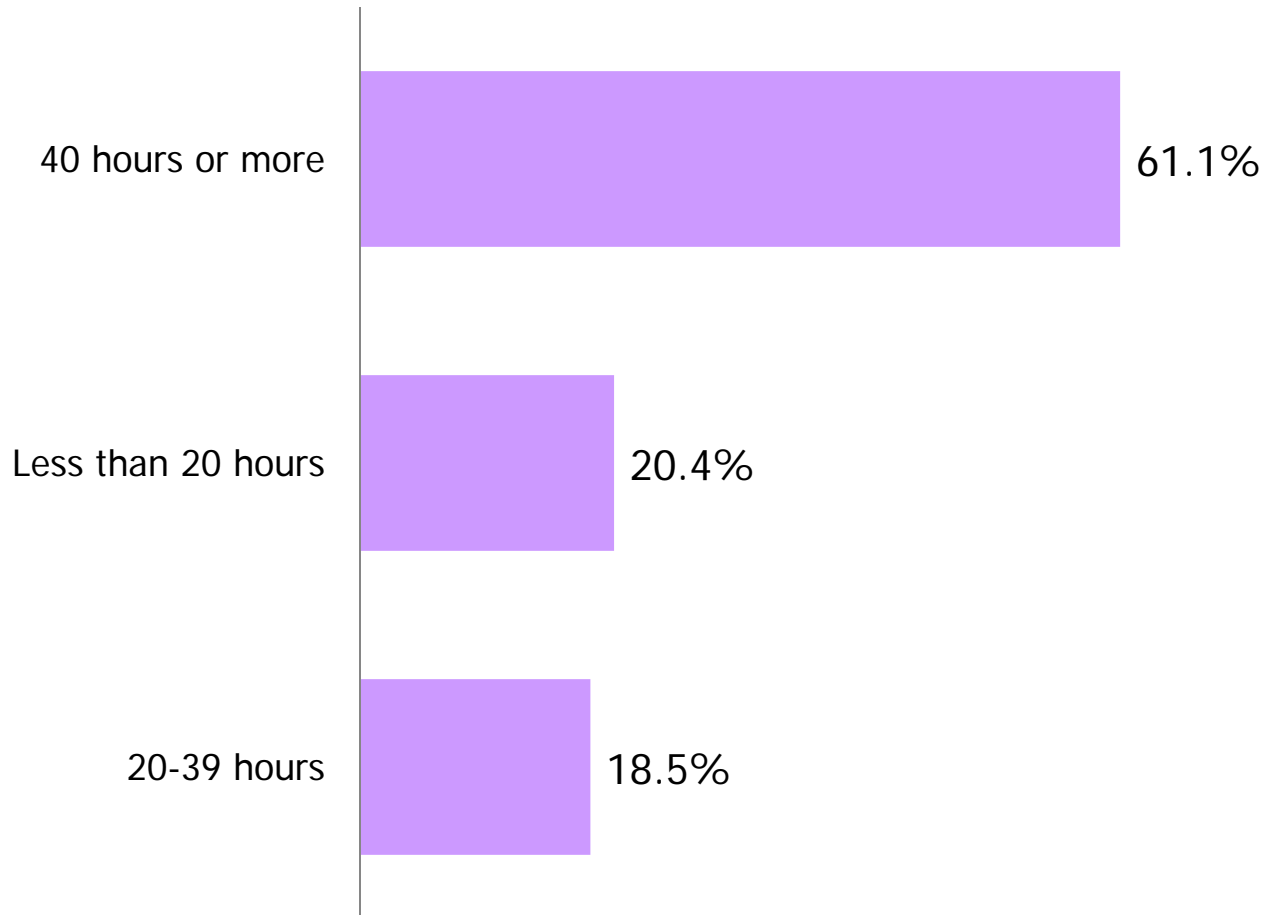
# 34. What is the highest level of education you have completed?



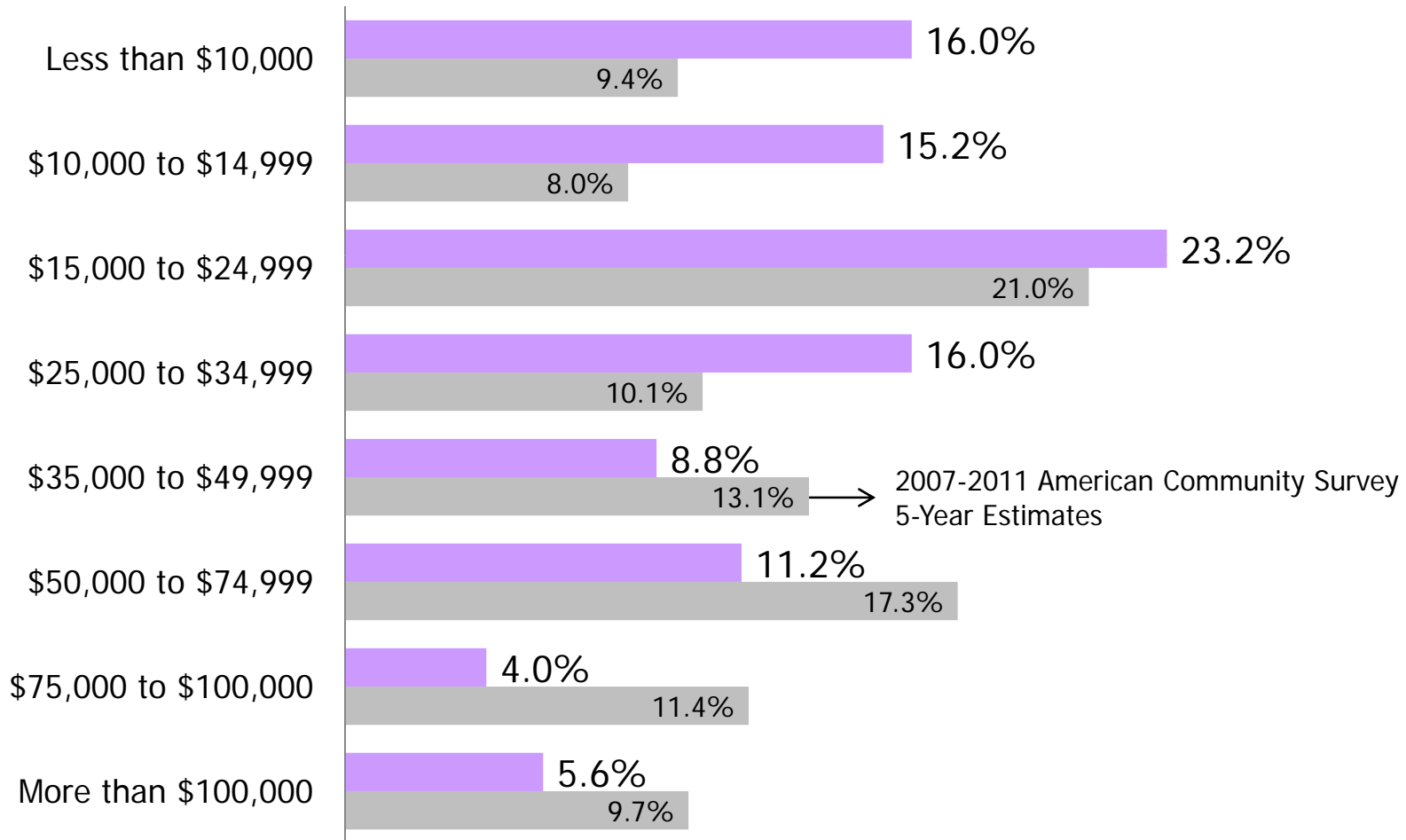

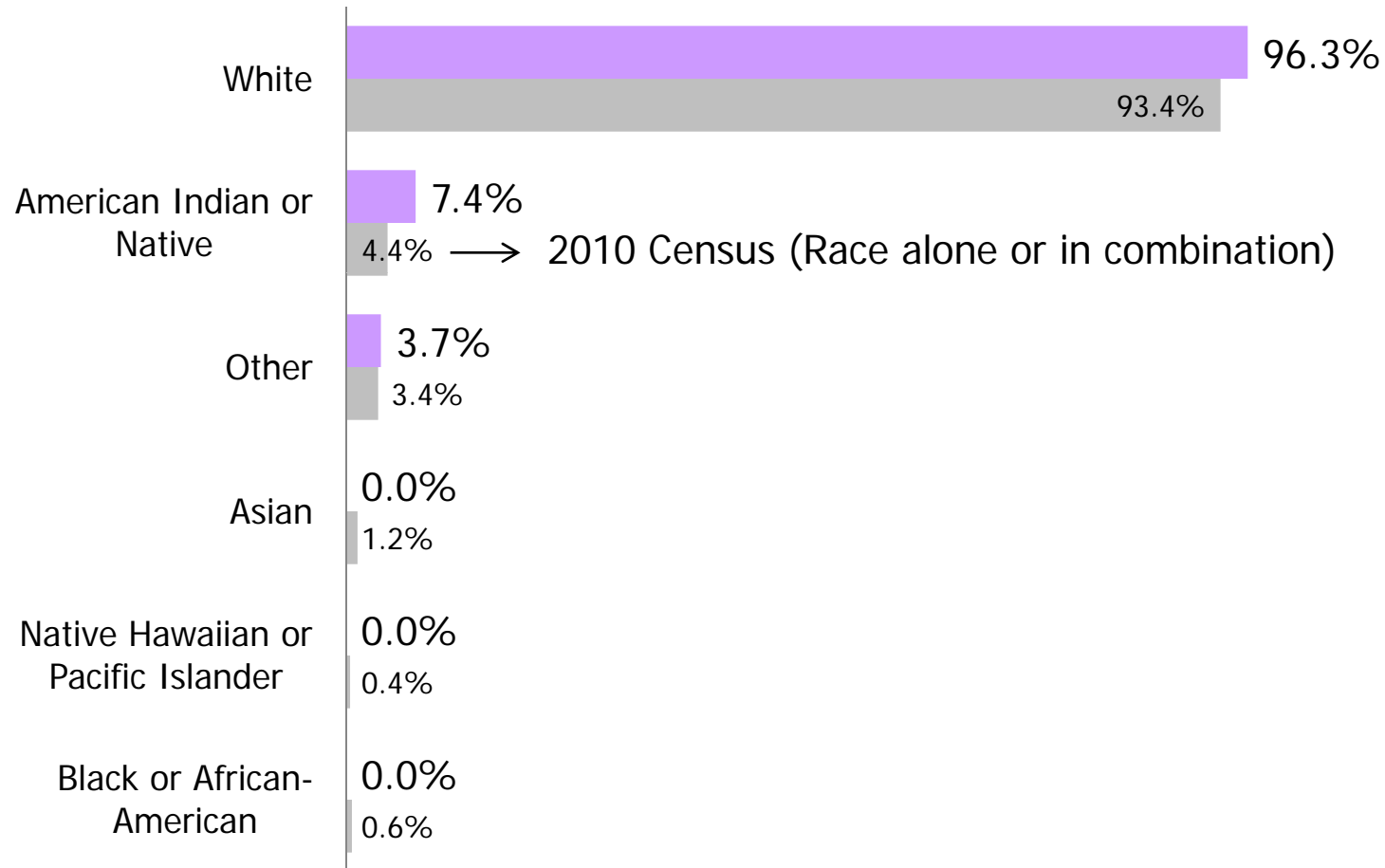

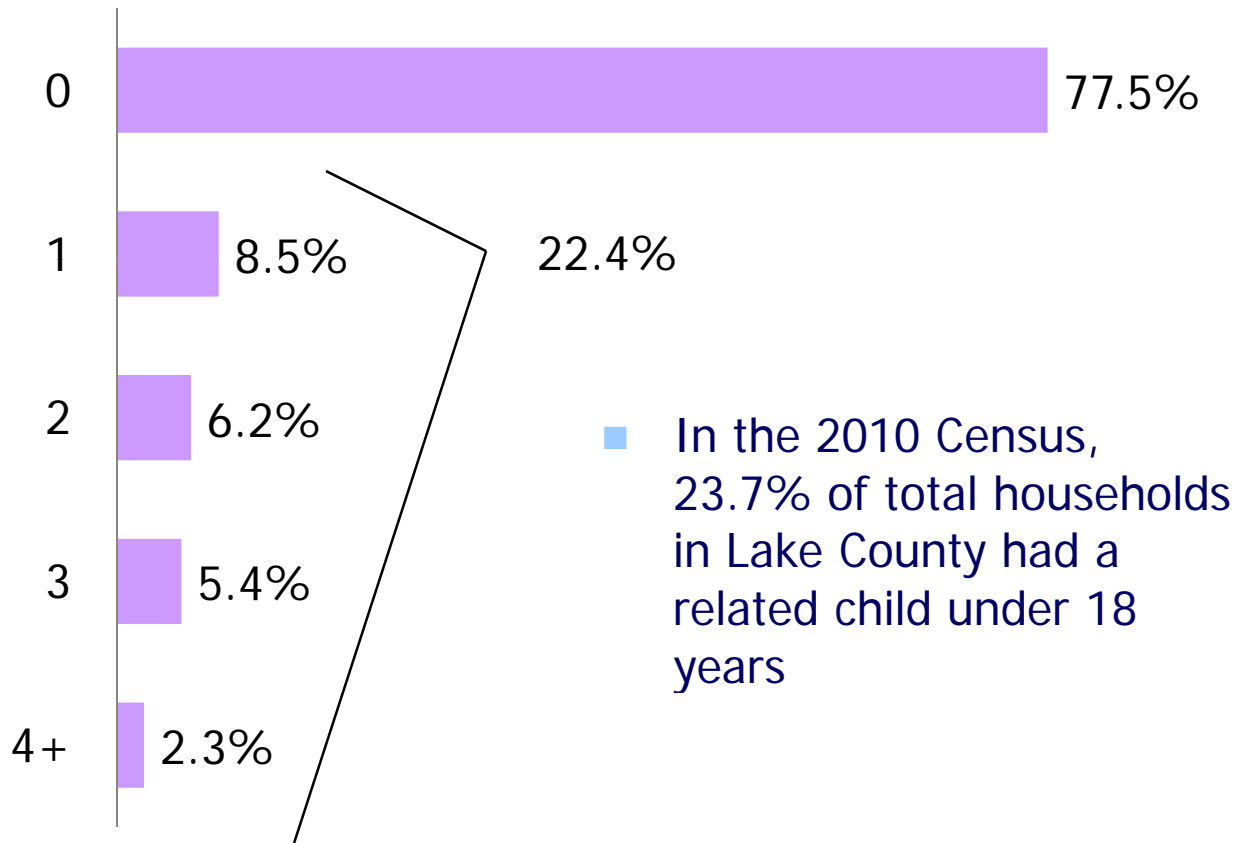

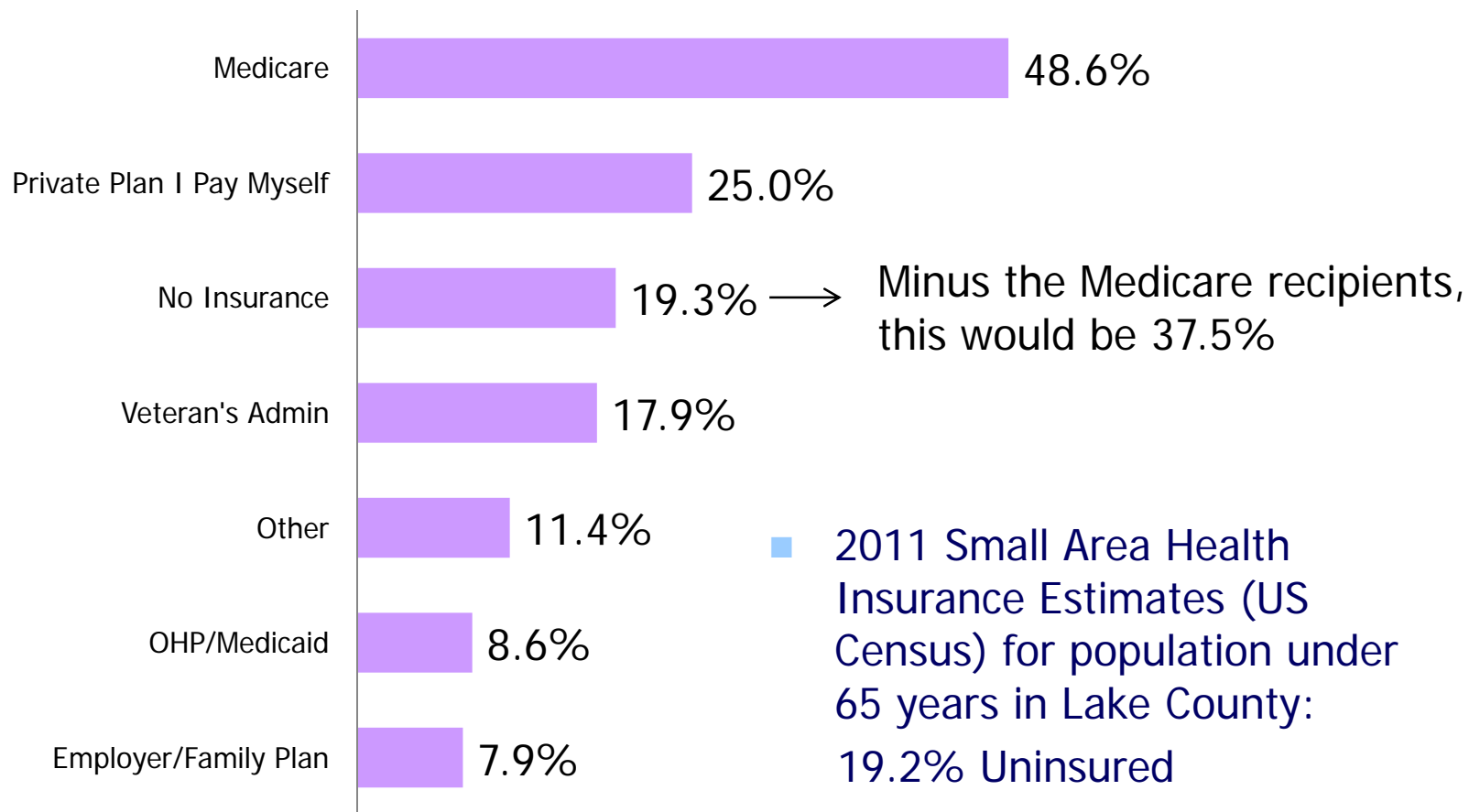

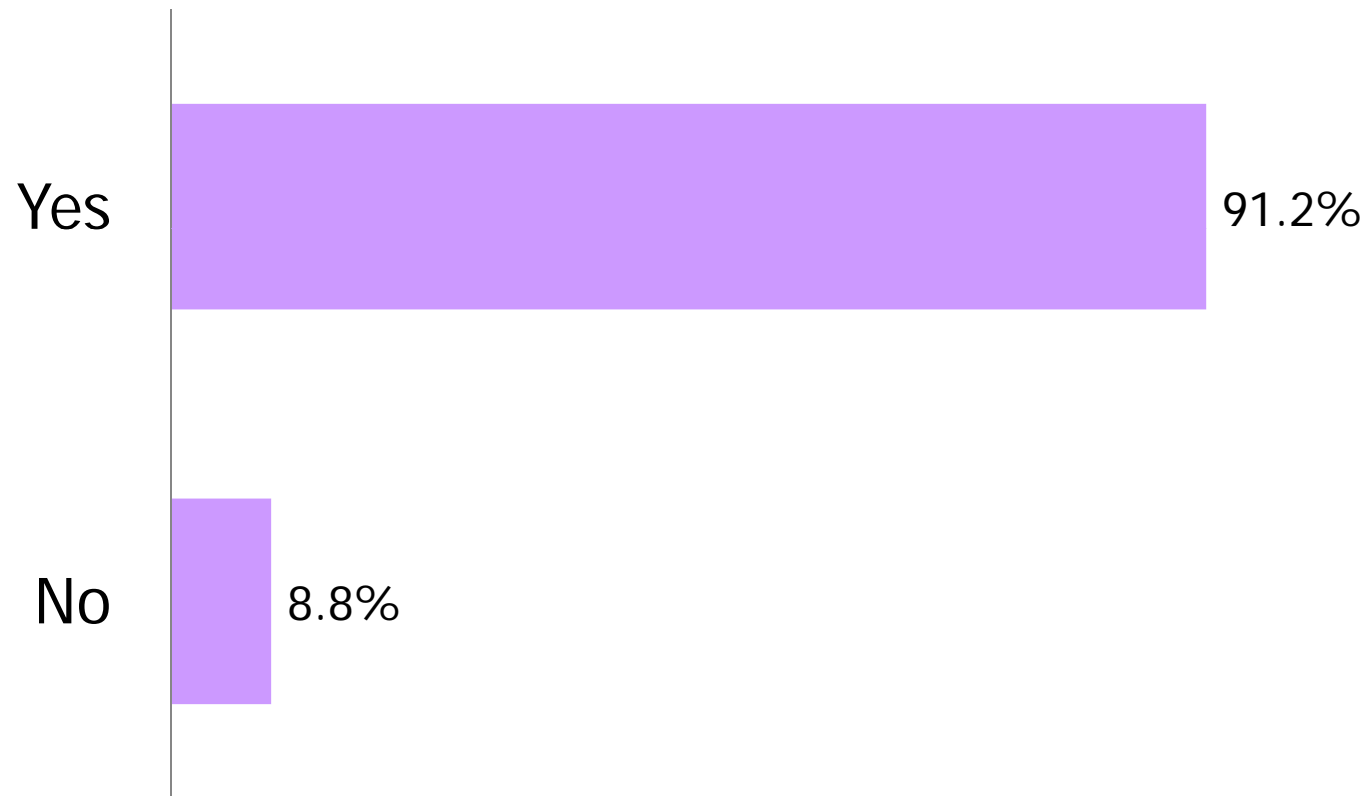

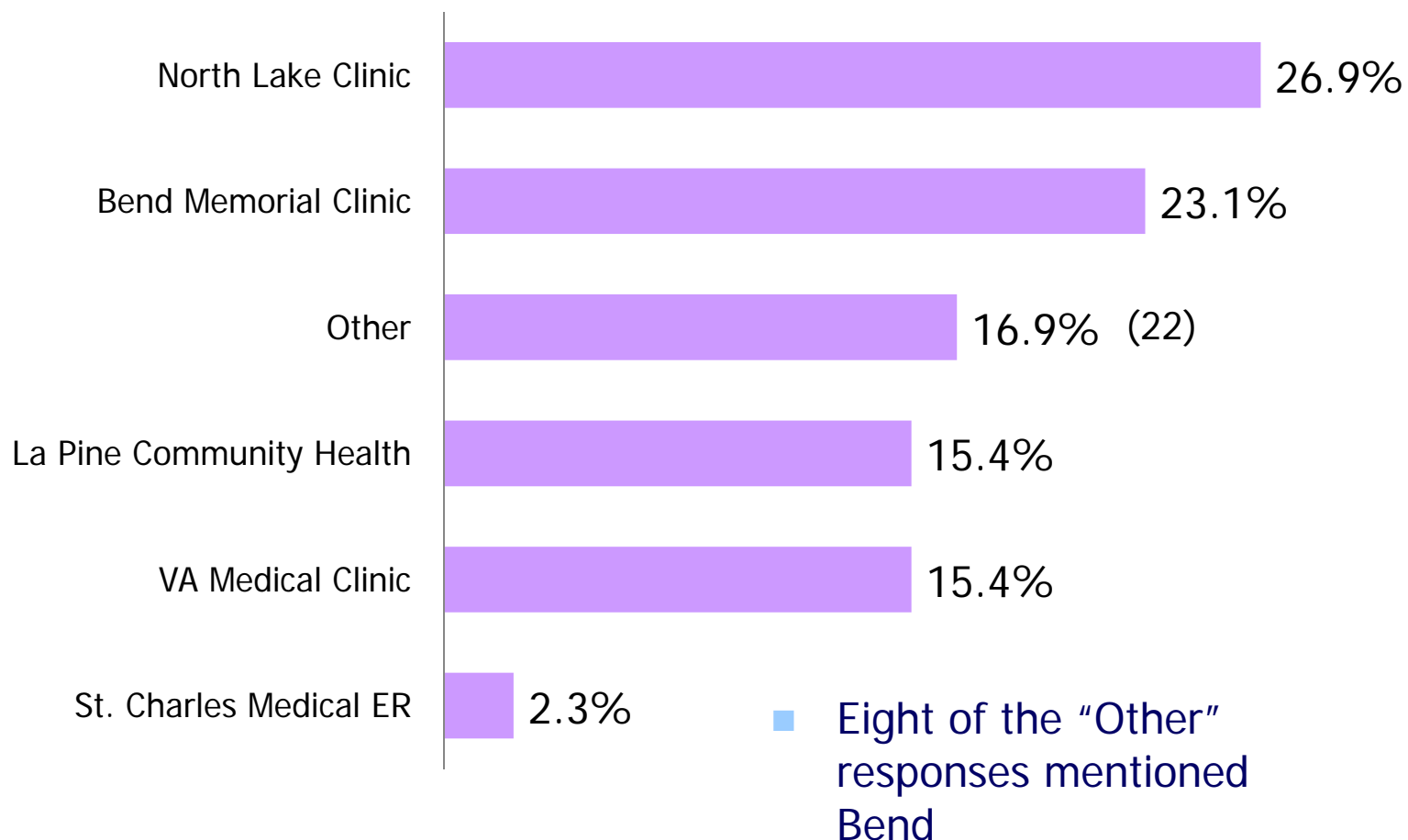

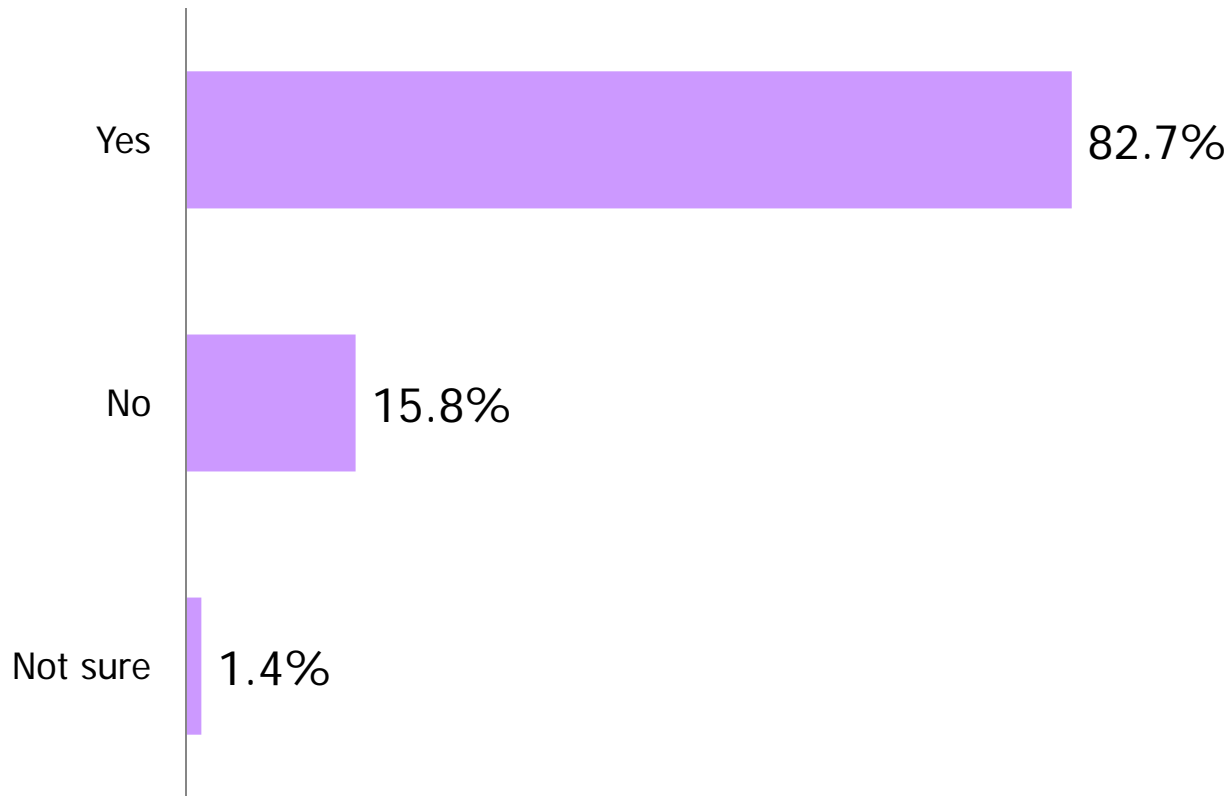

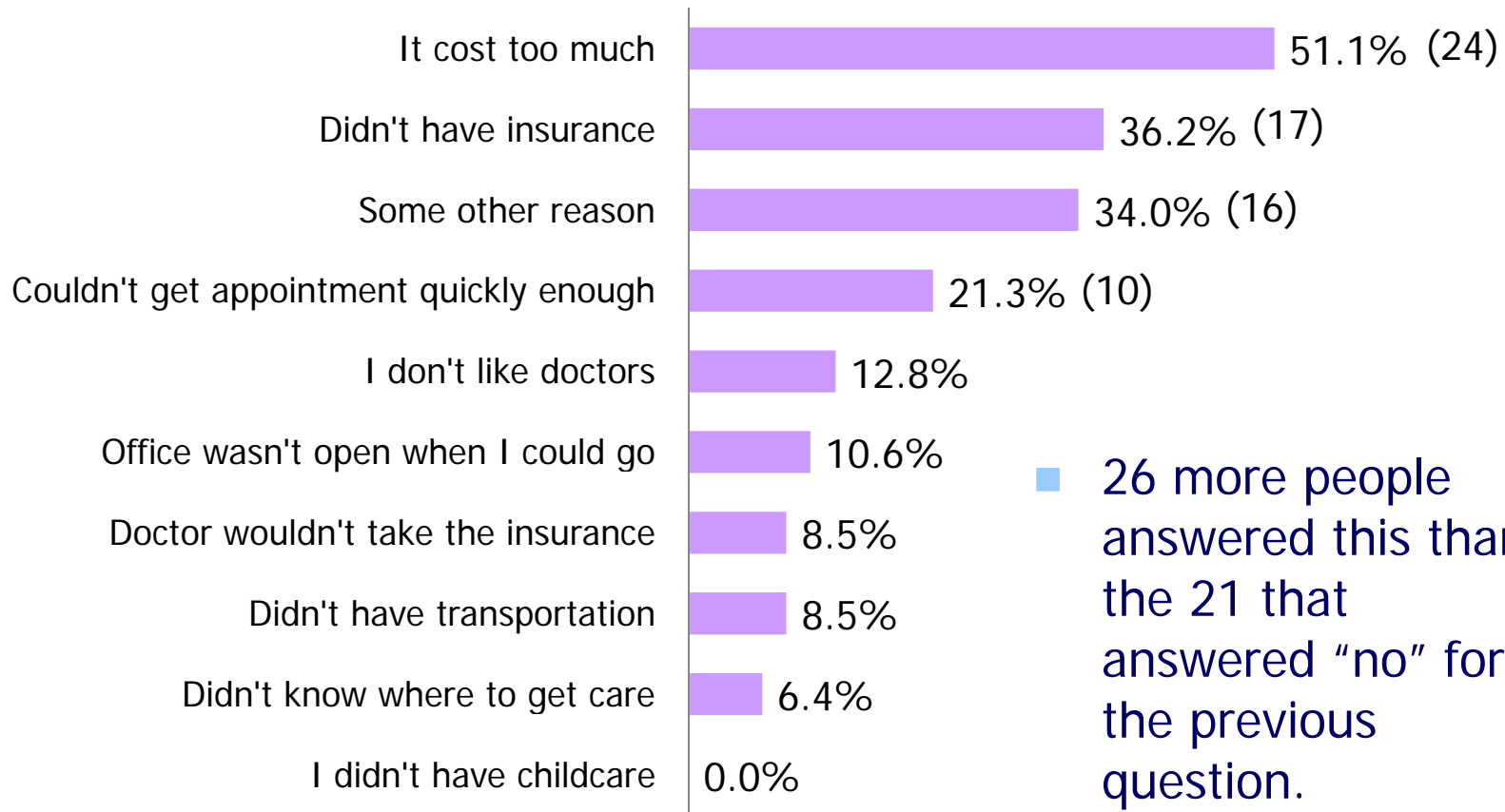
6. Thinking about the last 6 months, was there a time when you or someone in your household needed medical care?



7. If you or someone in your household needed care in the last 6 months, did they get all the care they needed?

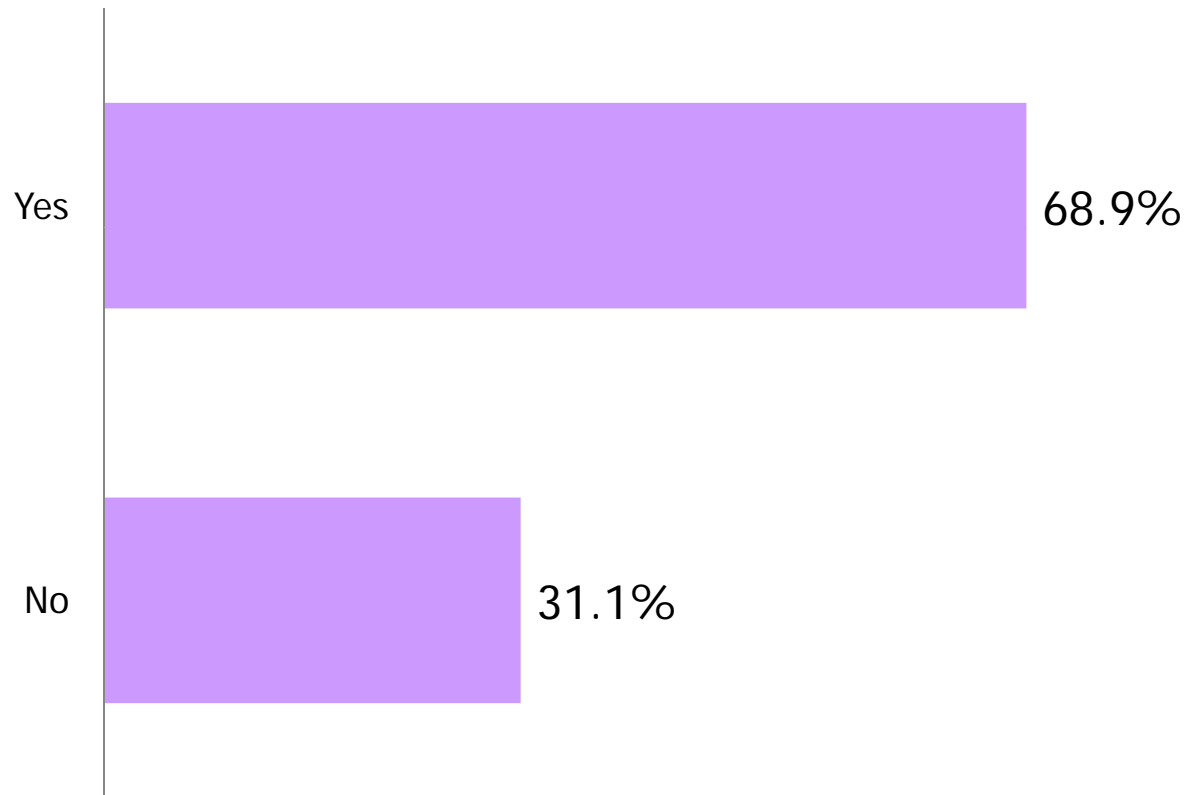


## 8. Thinking about the most recent time you went with out needed care, what were the main reasons? Mark all that apply.

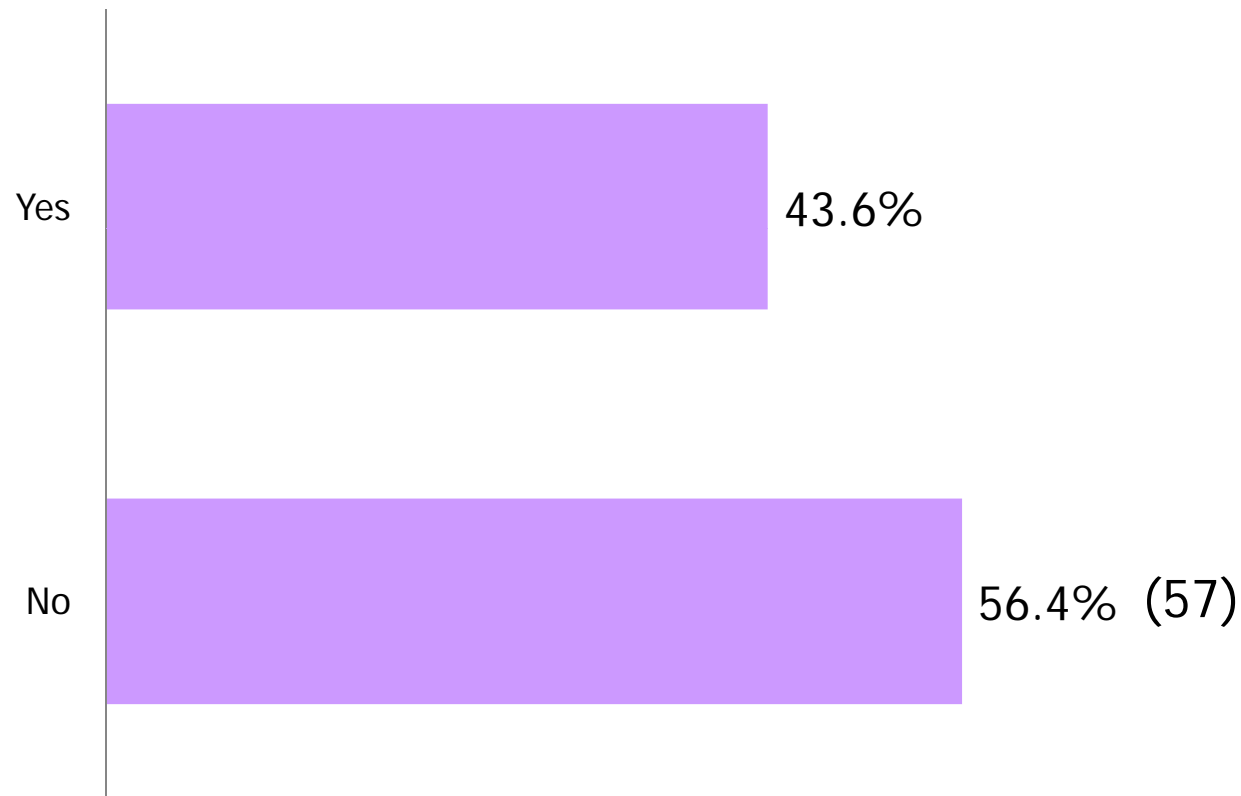

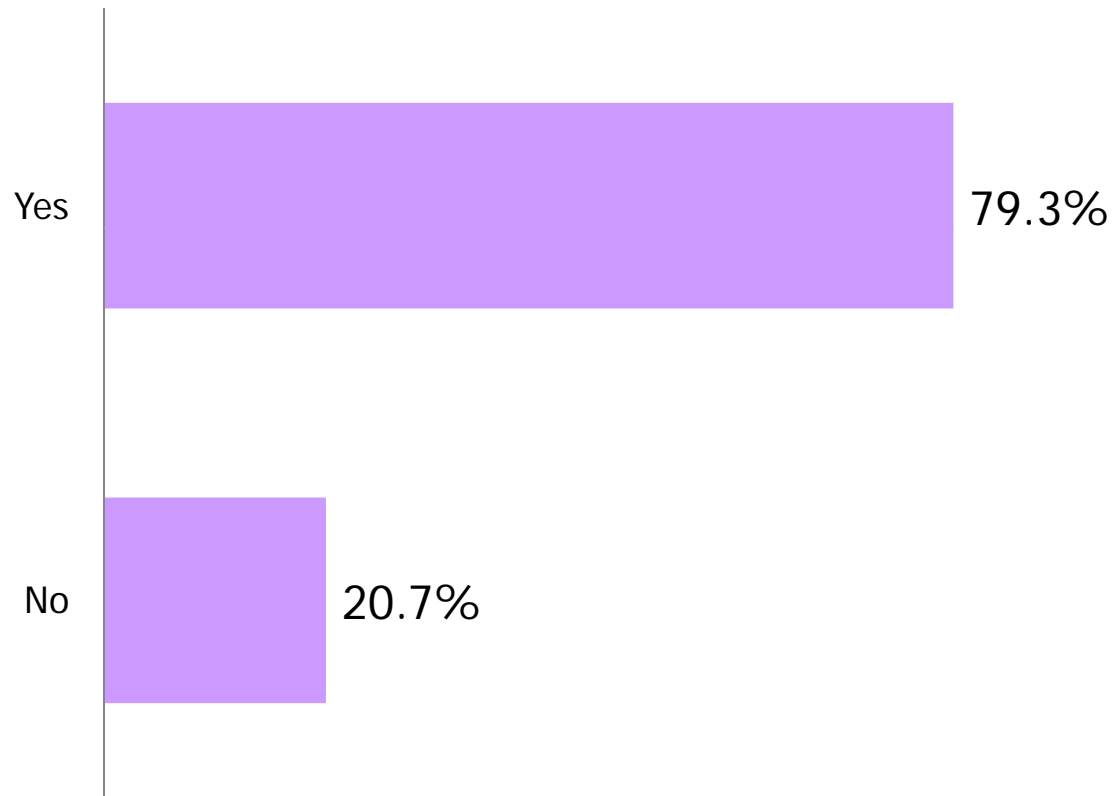

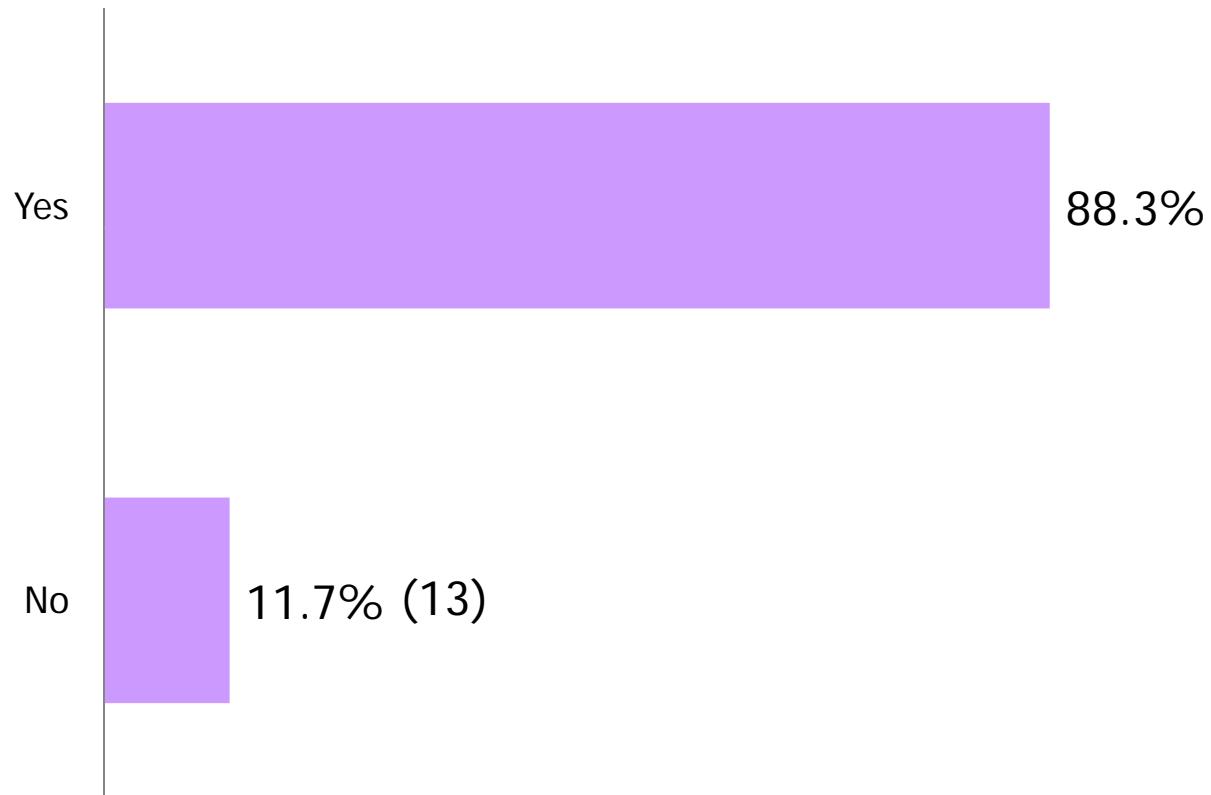
10. If you or someone in your household needed dental care in the last 6 months, did they get all the care they needed?



11. Thinking of the last 6 months, was there a time when you or someone in your household needed prescription medications?

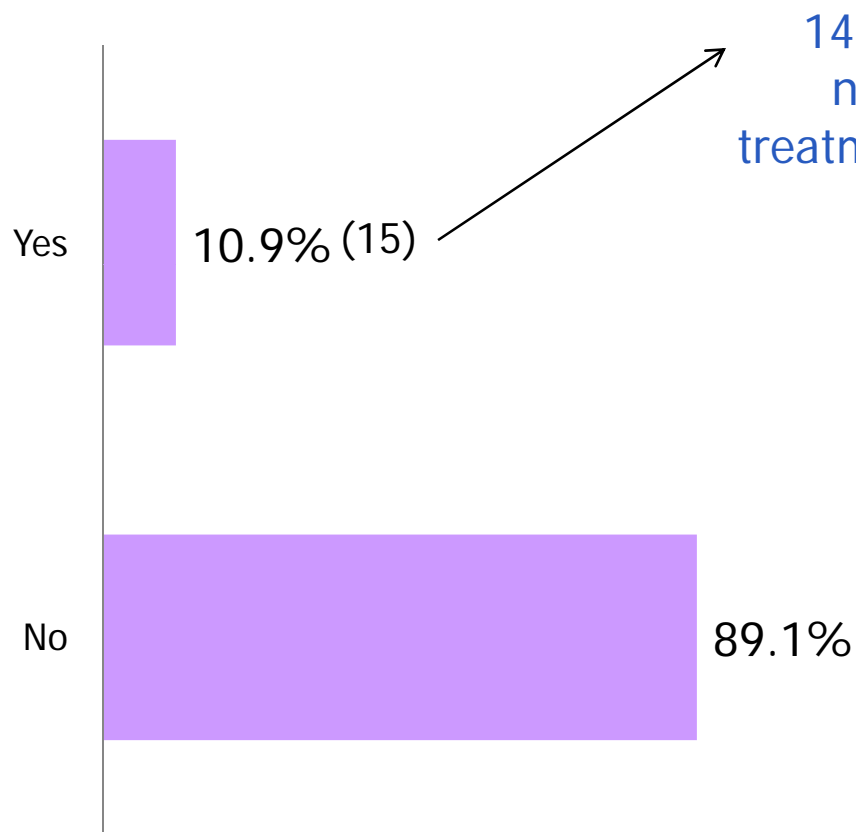


12. If you or someone in your household needed prescription medications in the last 6 months, did they get all the medications they needed?

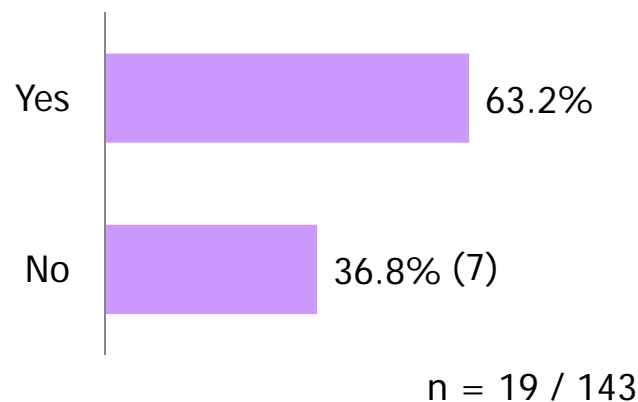




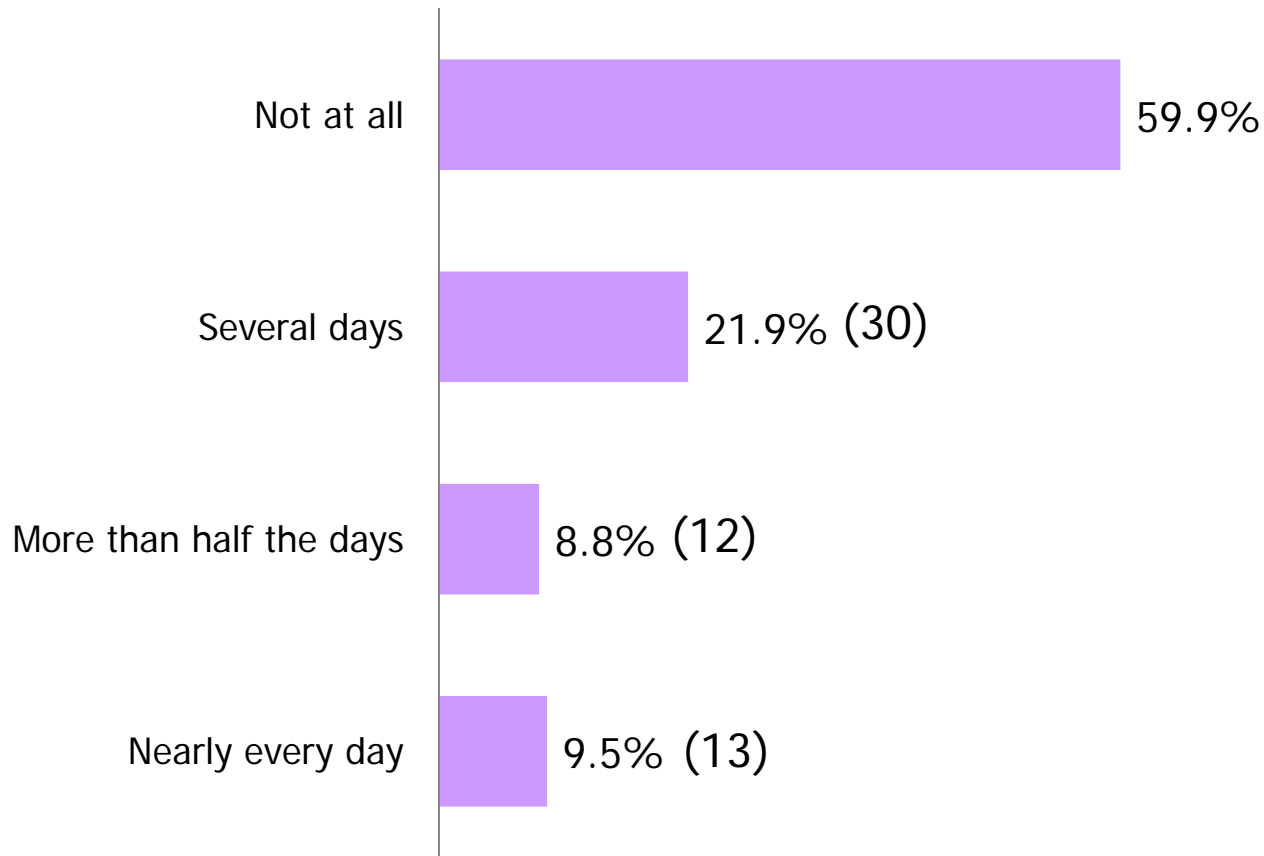

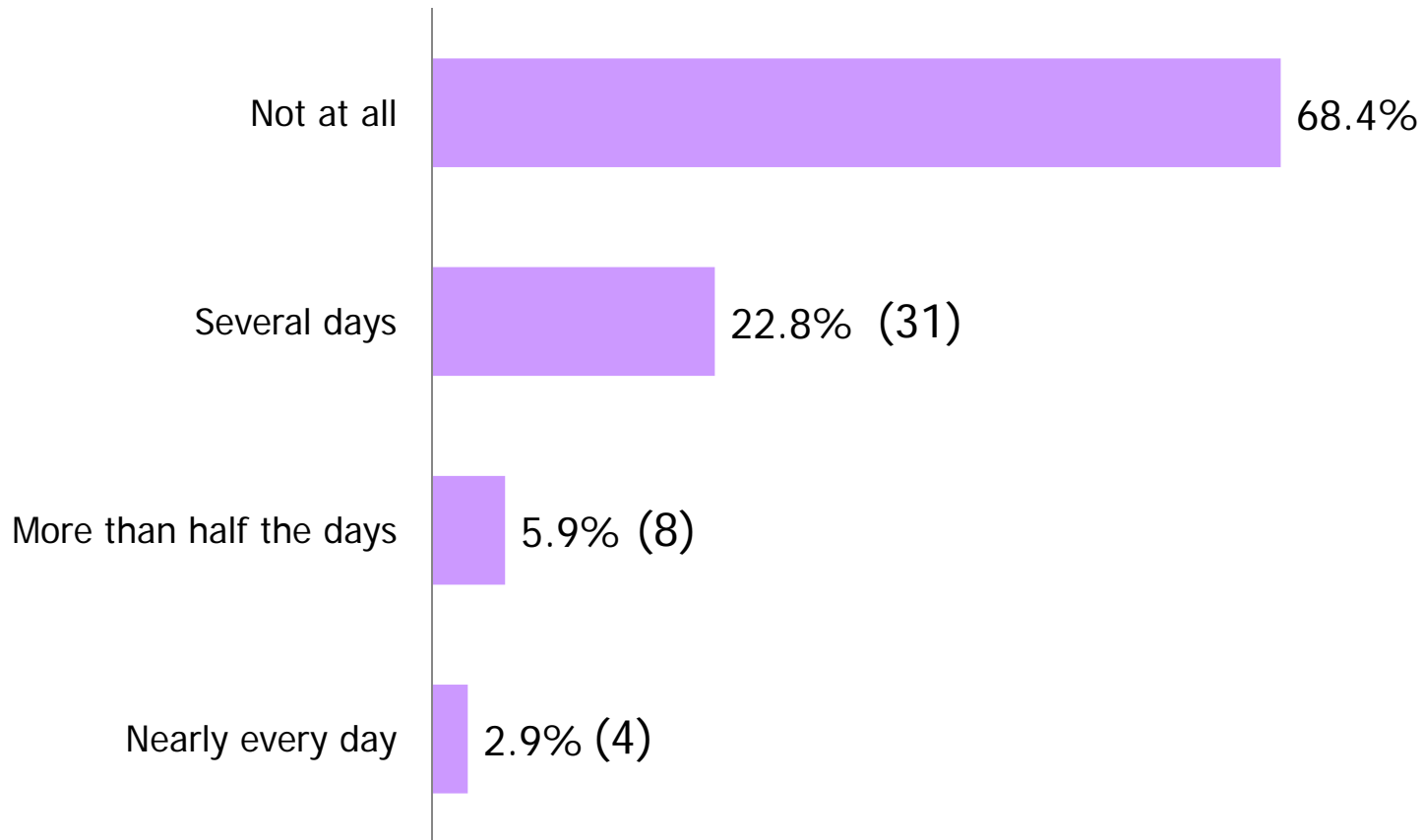
14. If you or someone in your household needed mental health or substance use treatment in the last 6 months, did they get all the help they needed?



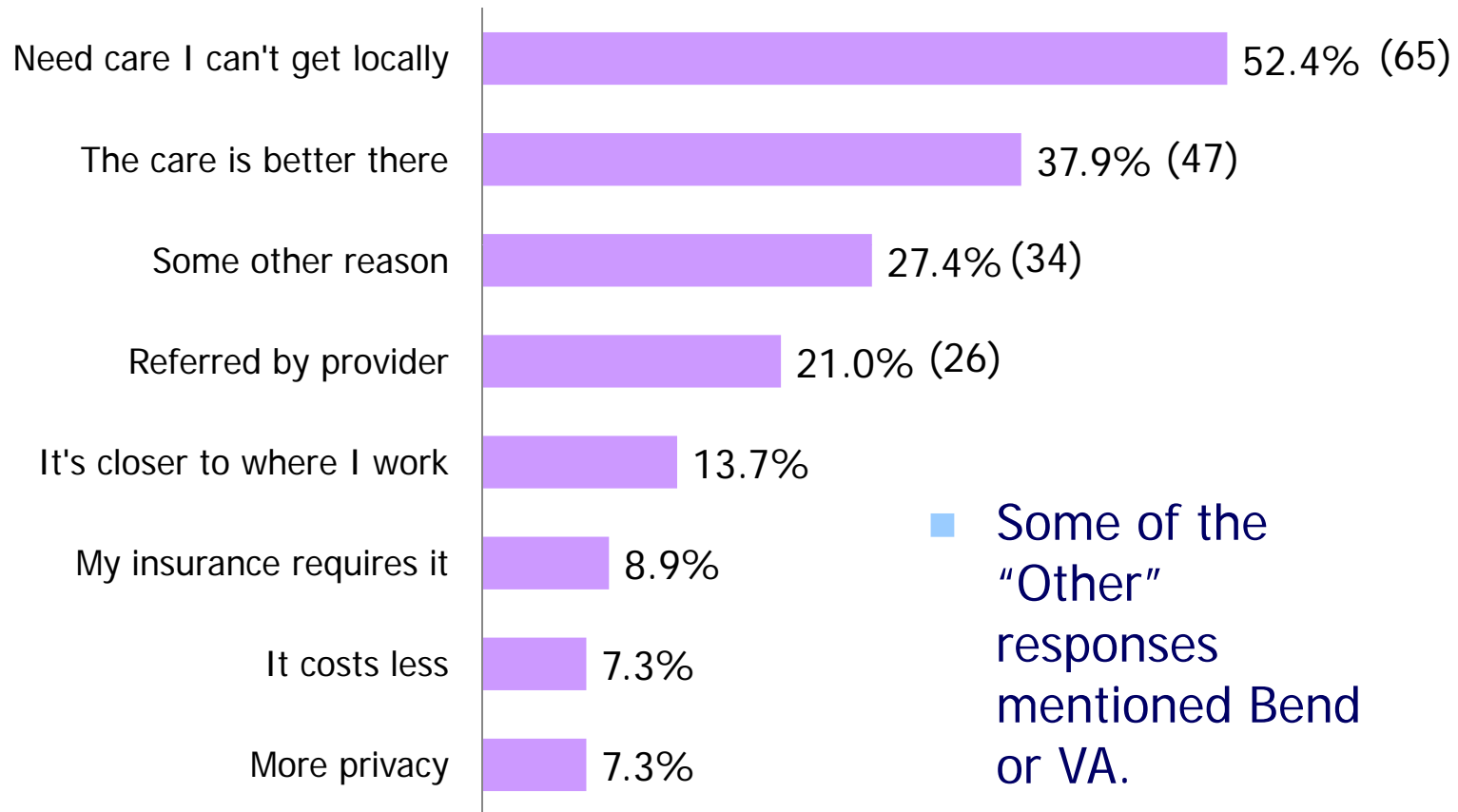
# 19. Over the past 2 weeks, how often have you been bothered by little interest or pleasure in doing things?



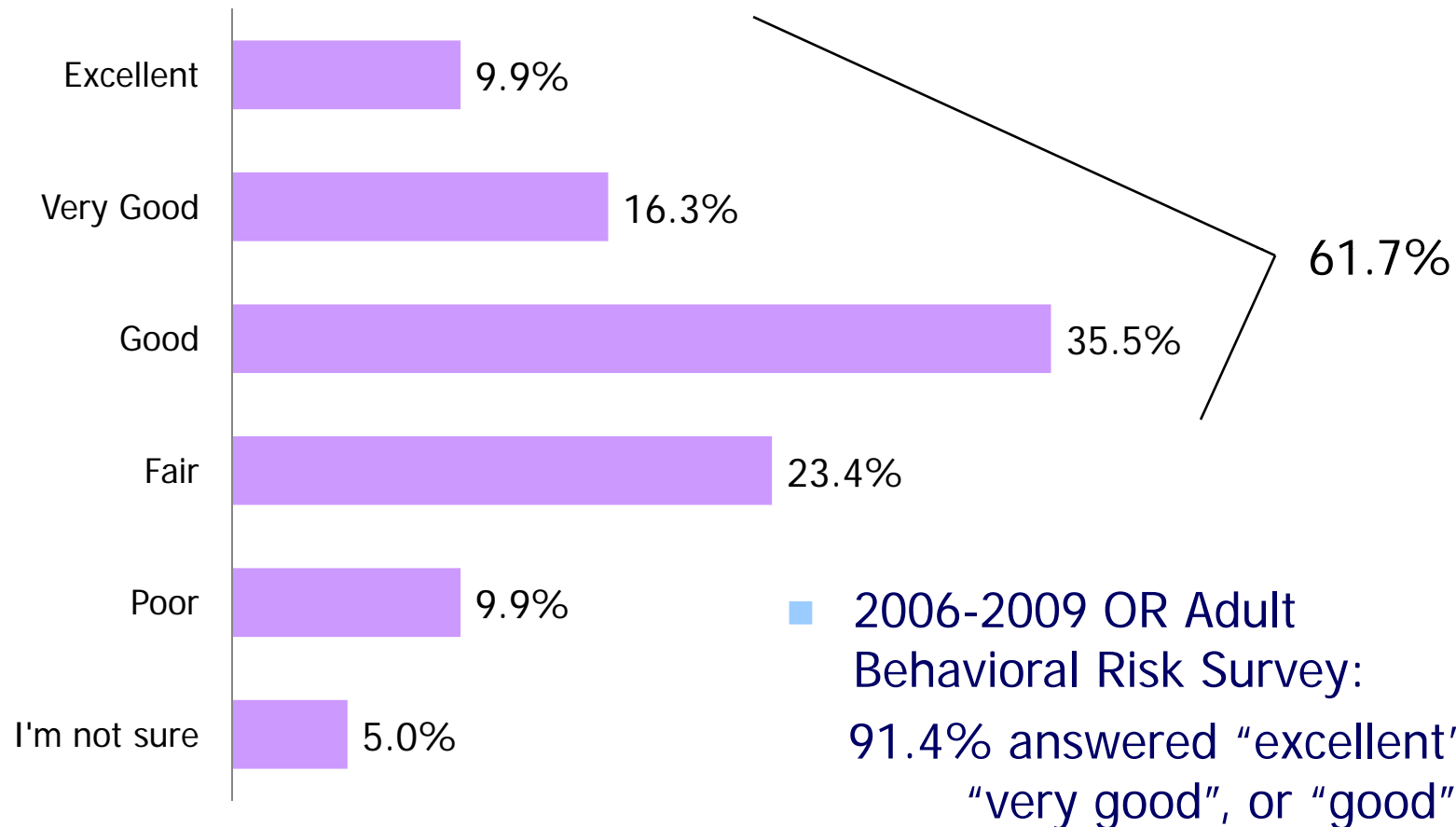

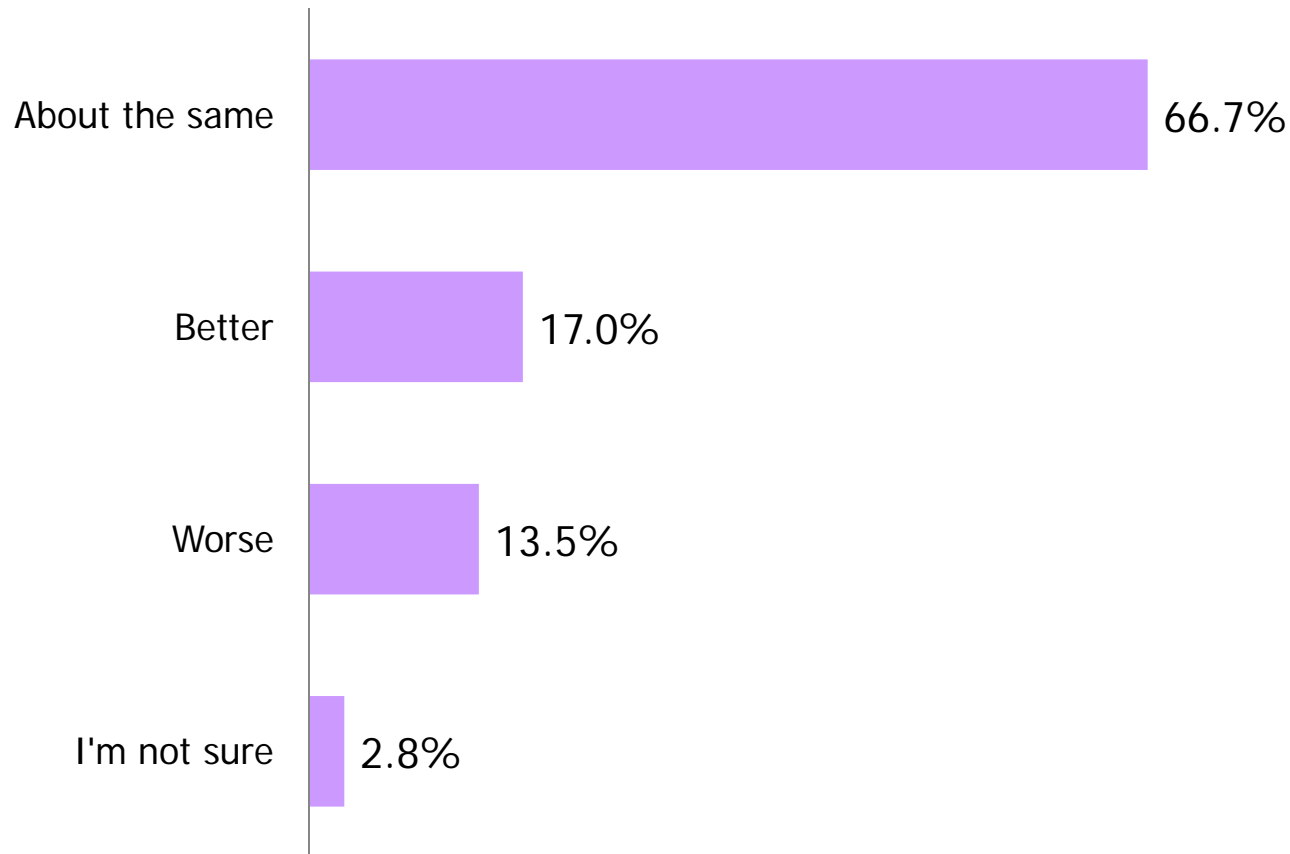

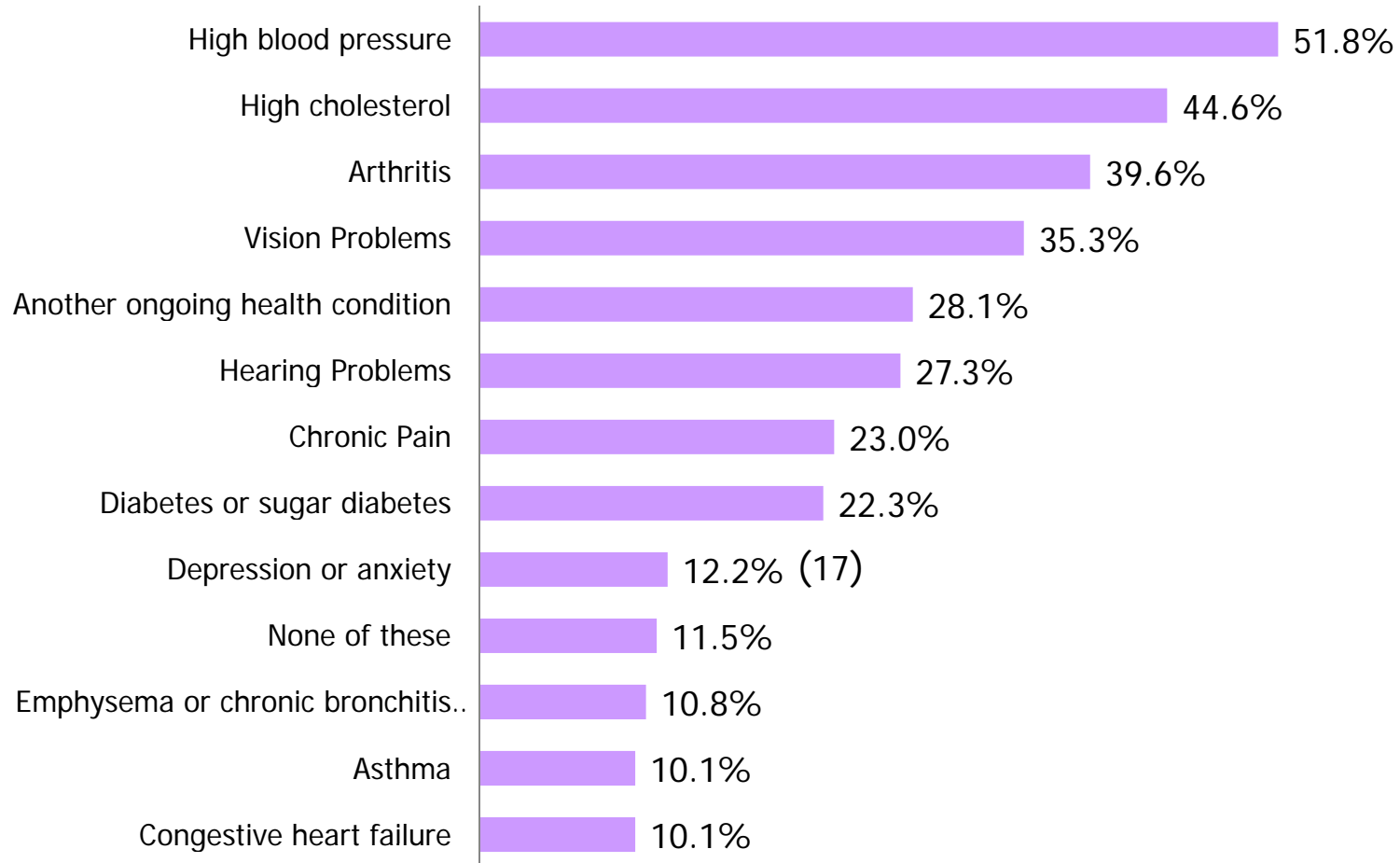

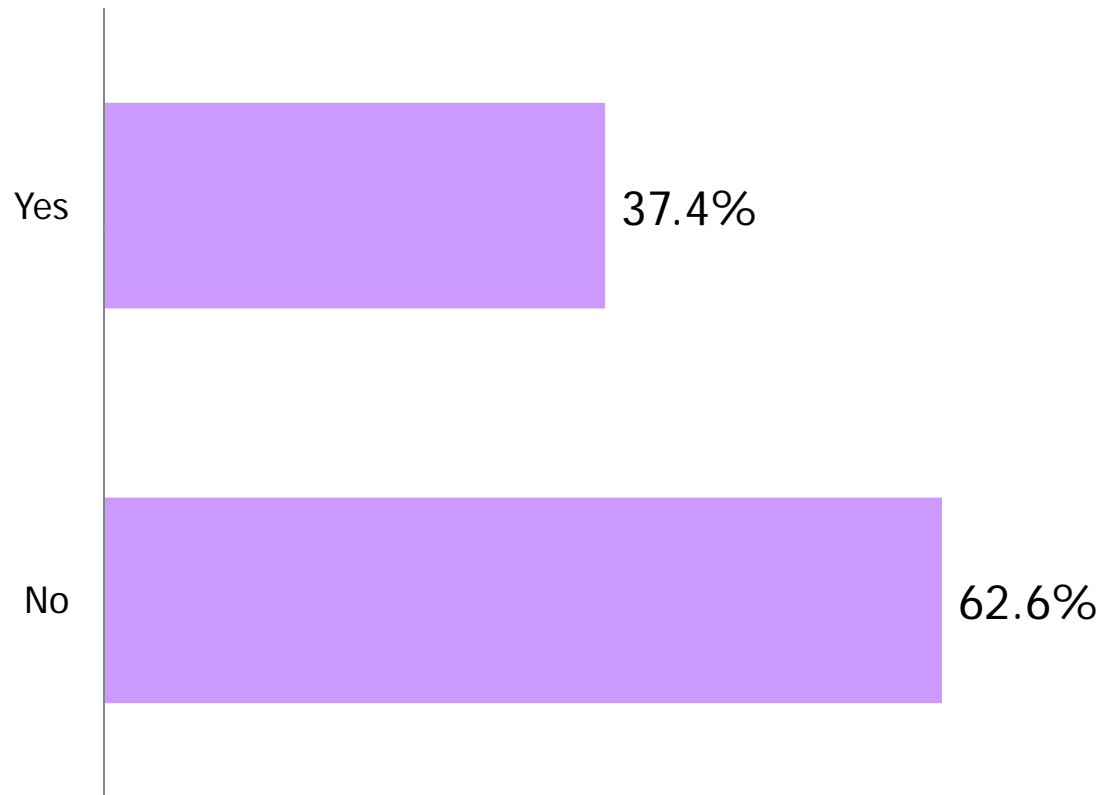

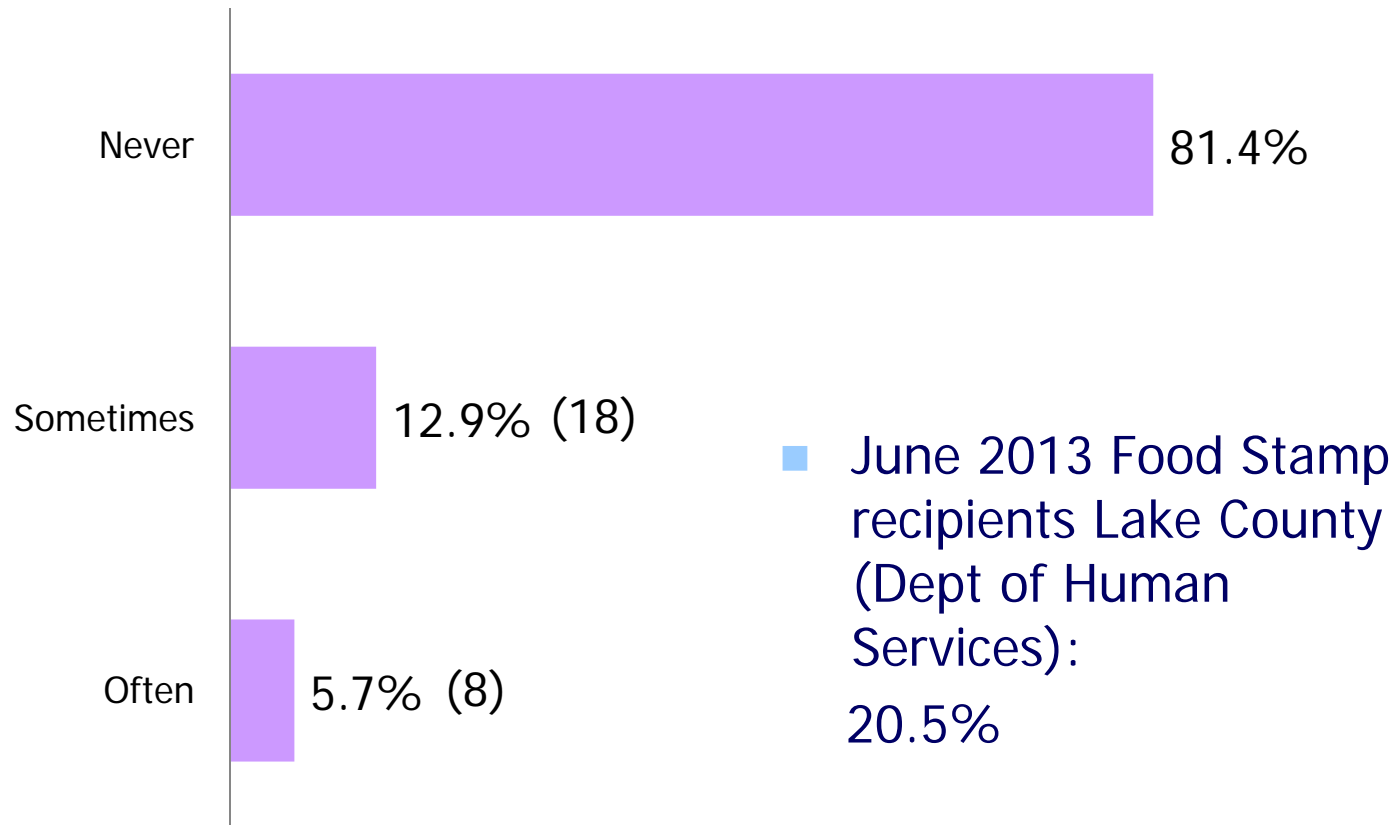

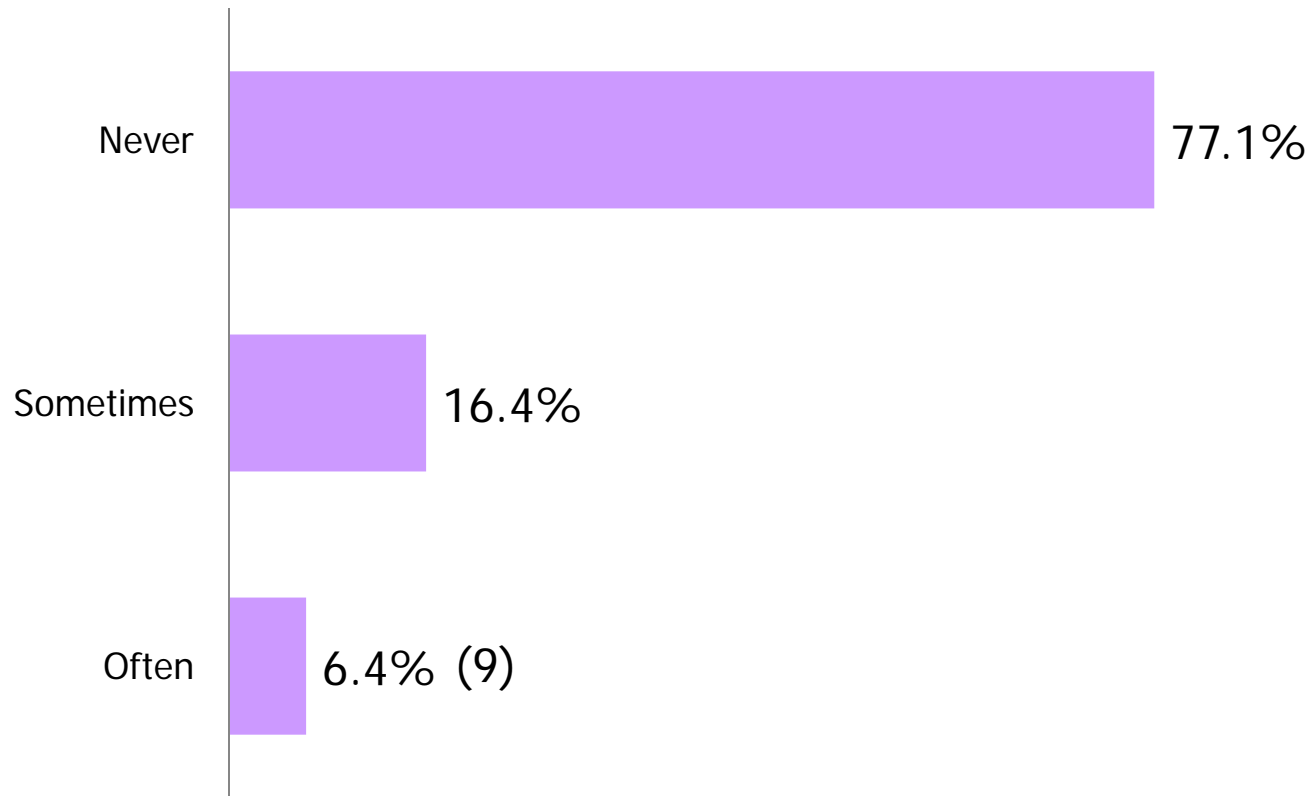




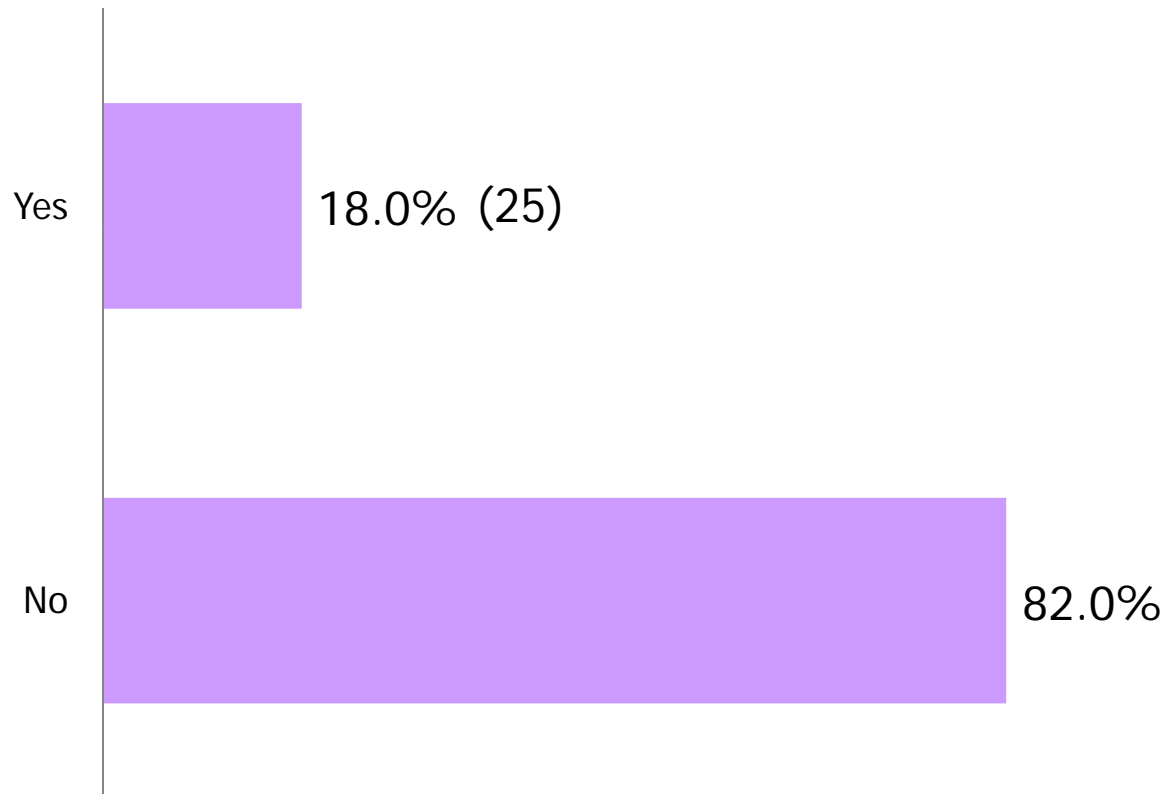
22. In the last 12 months, how often have you or members of your household ever cut the size of meals or skipped meals because there wasn't enough money for food?



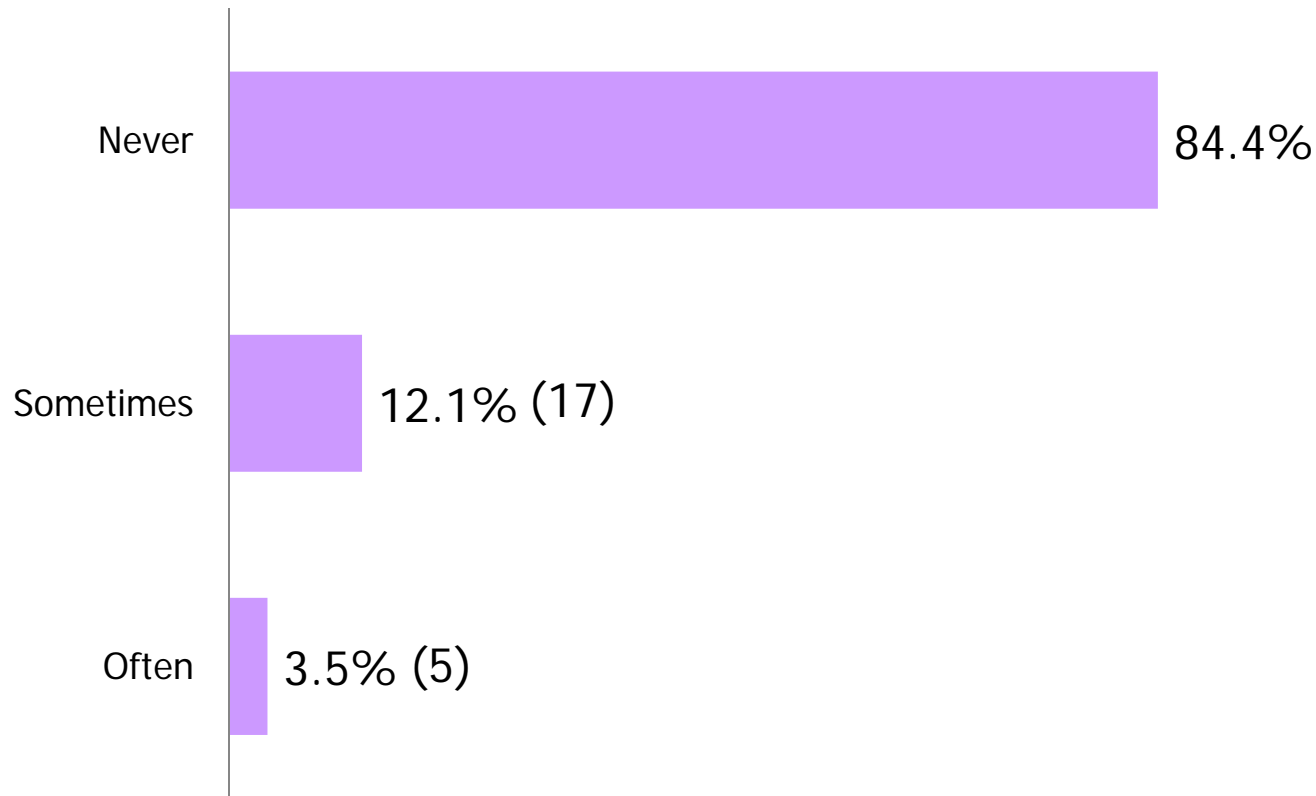
23. In the last 12 months, how often have you been worried that your food would run out before you got money to buy more?



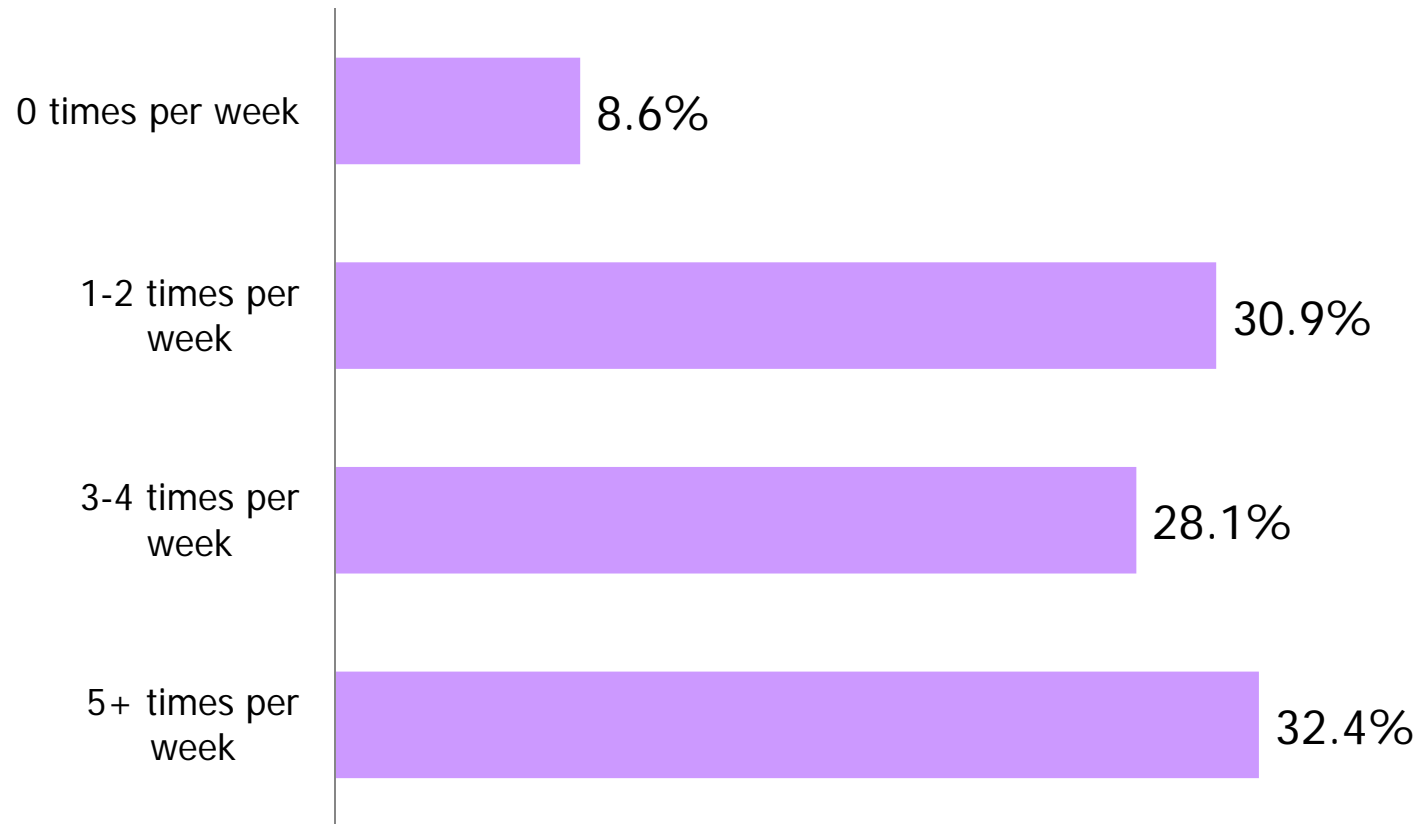

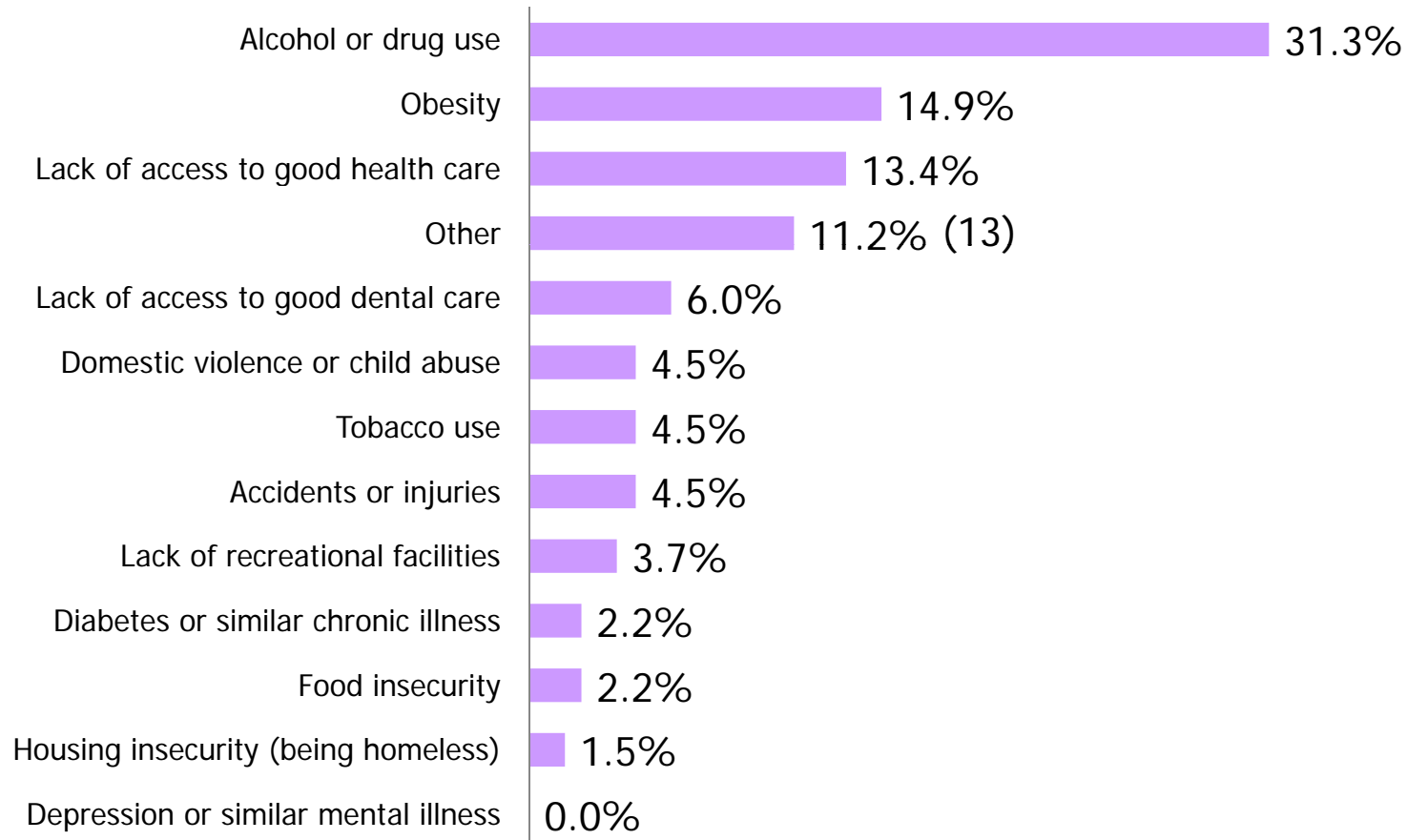

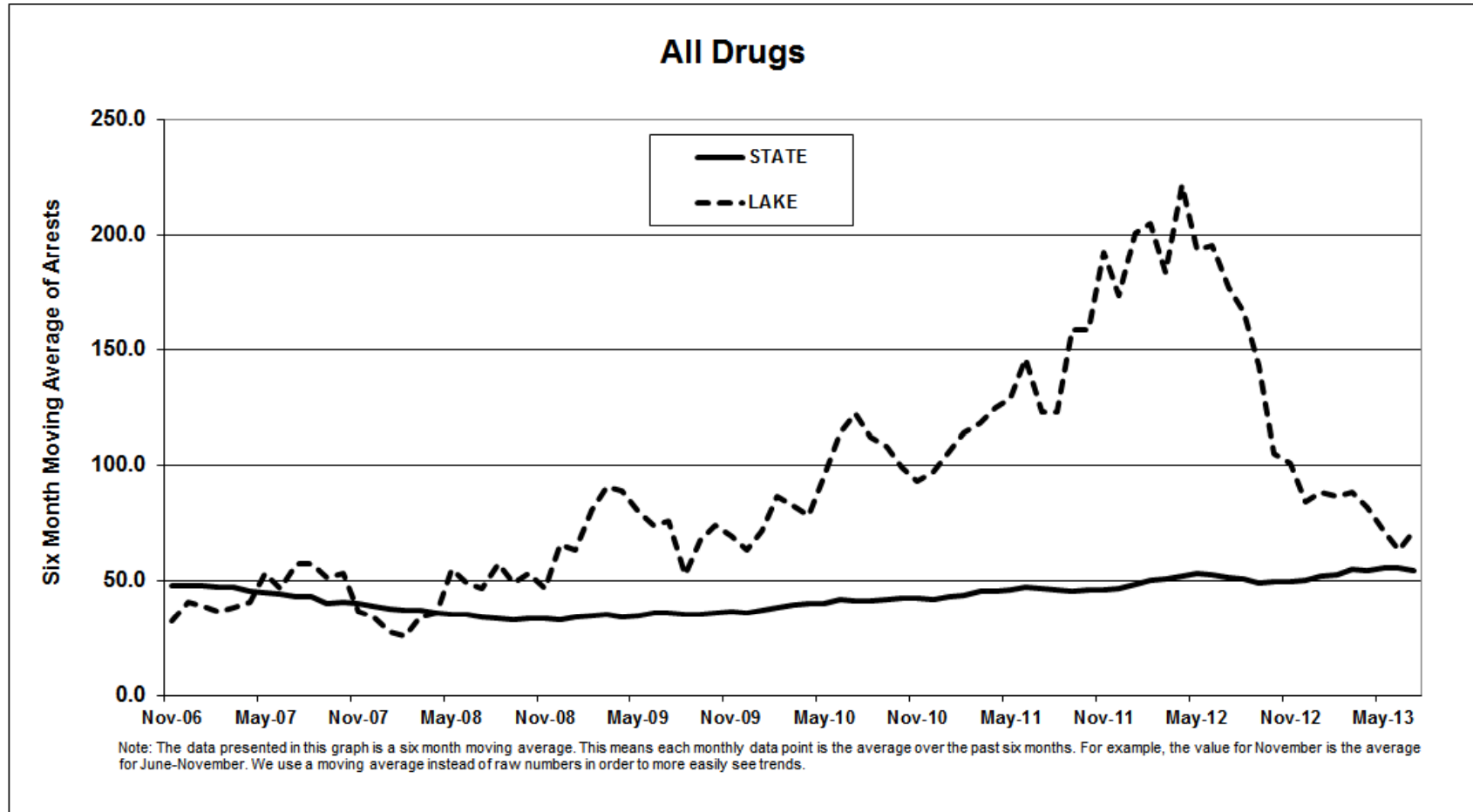

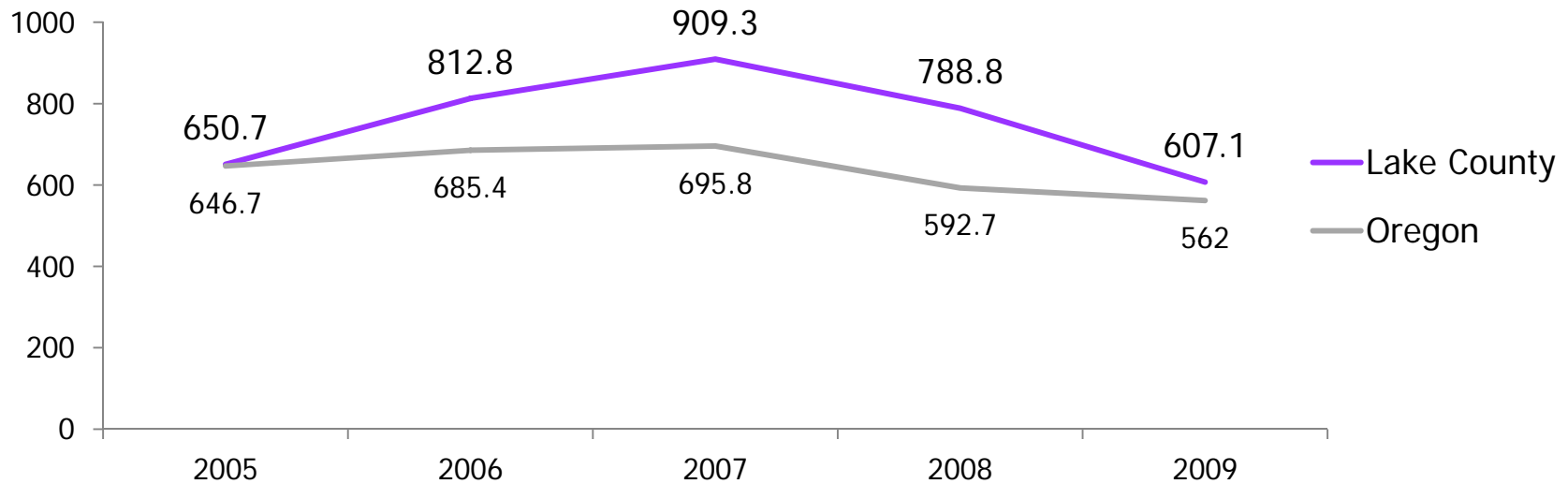
27. Which of the following would you say is the most important health concern your community is facing today? Mark only one.

# DUII Reported Offense Rate per 100,000 Population: 2005-2009

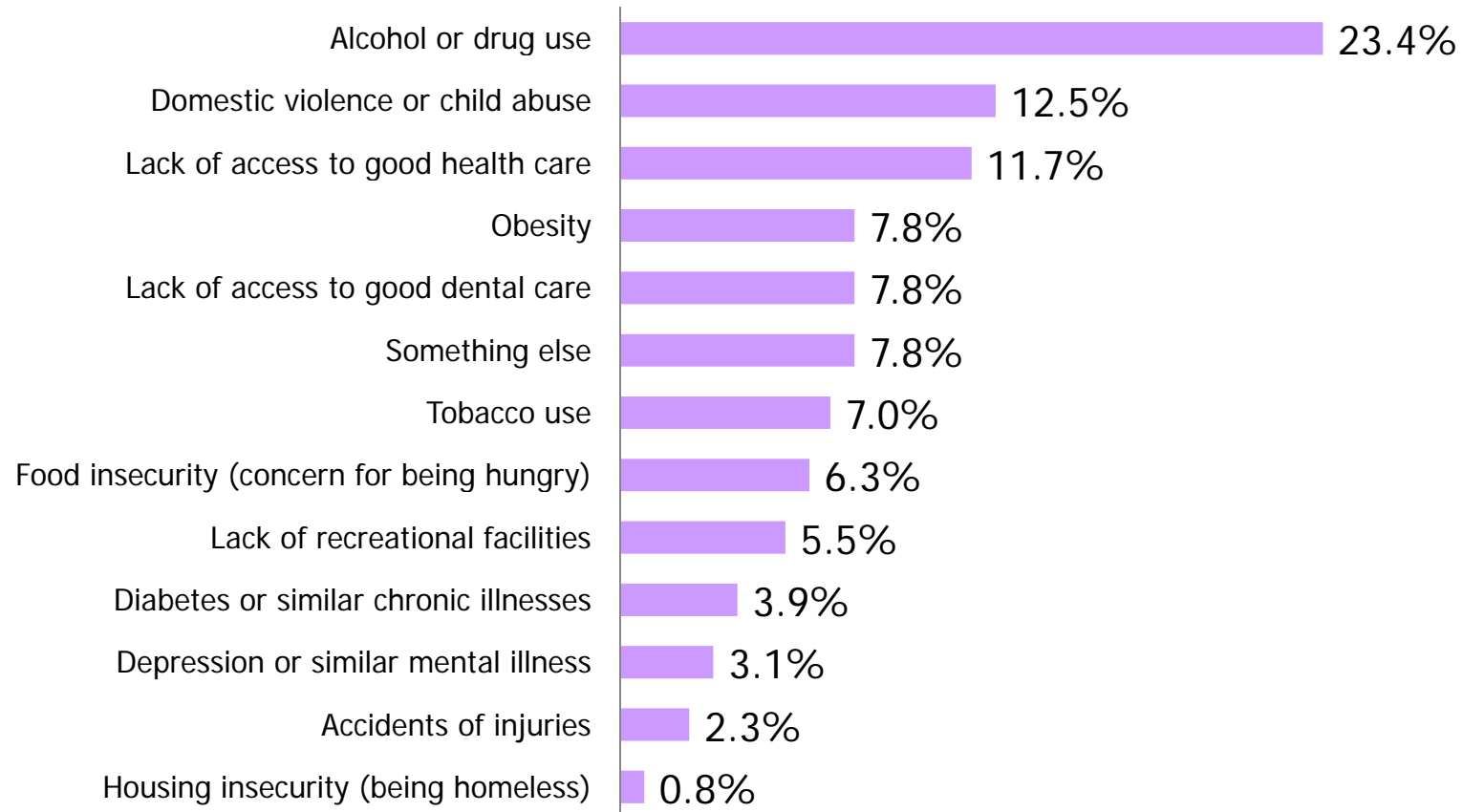

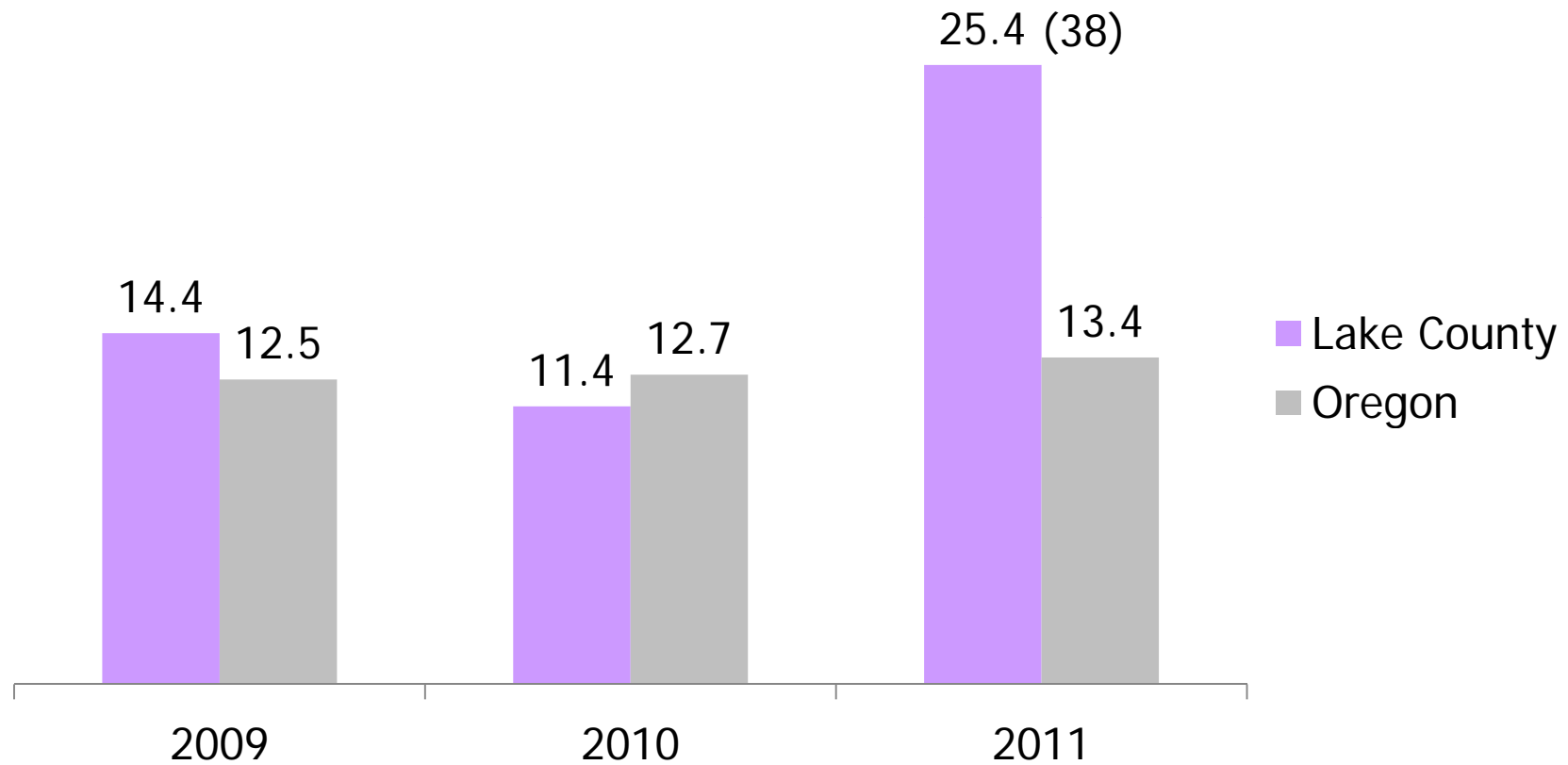

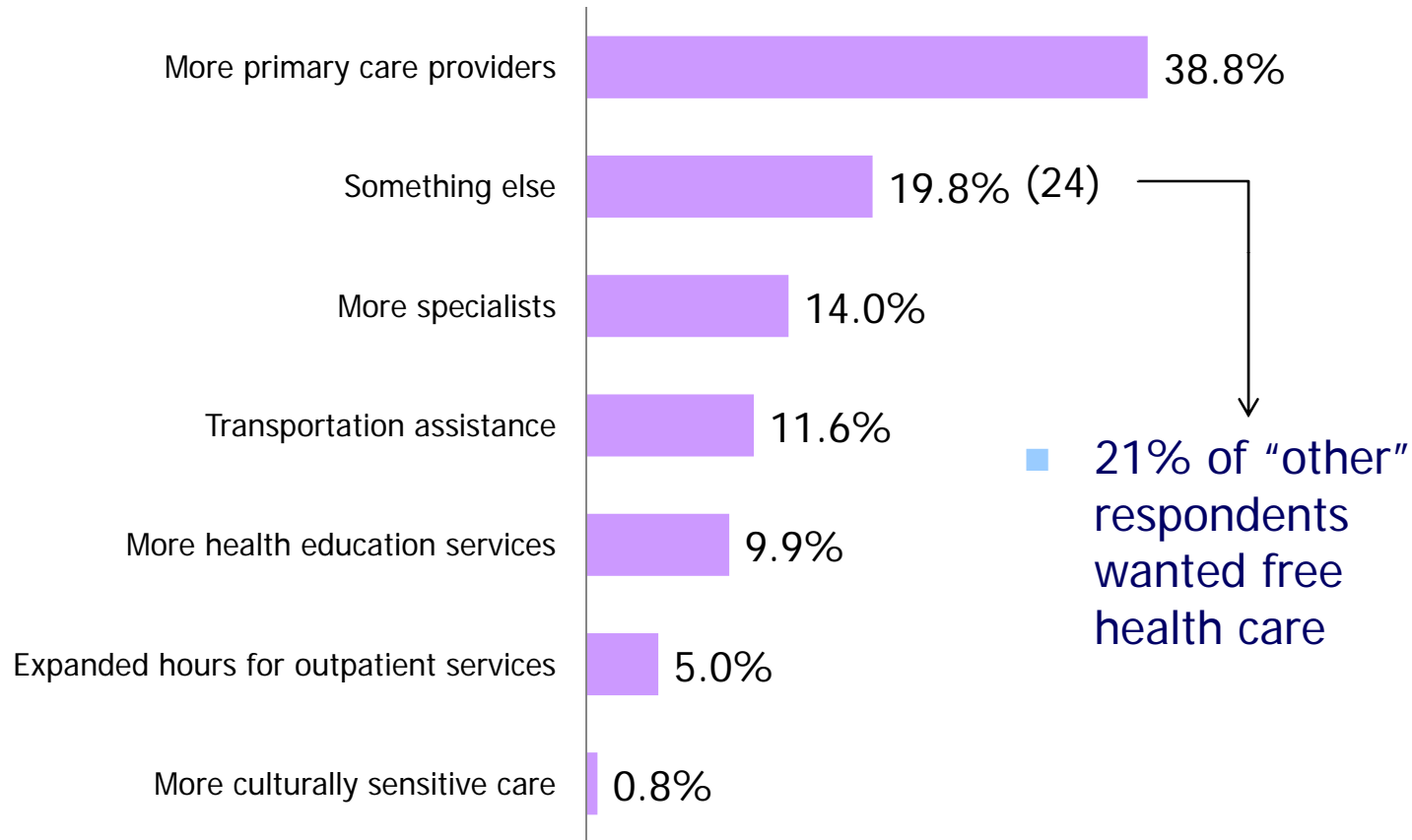
28. Which of the following would you say is the second most important health concern your community is facing today? Mark only one.



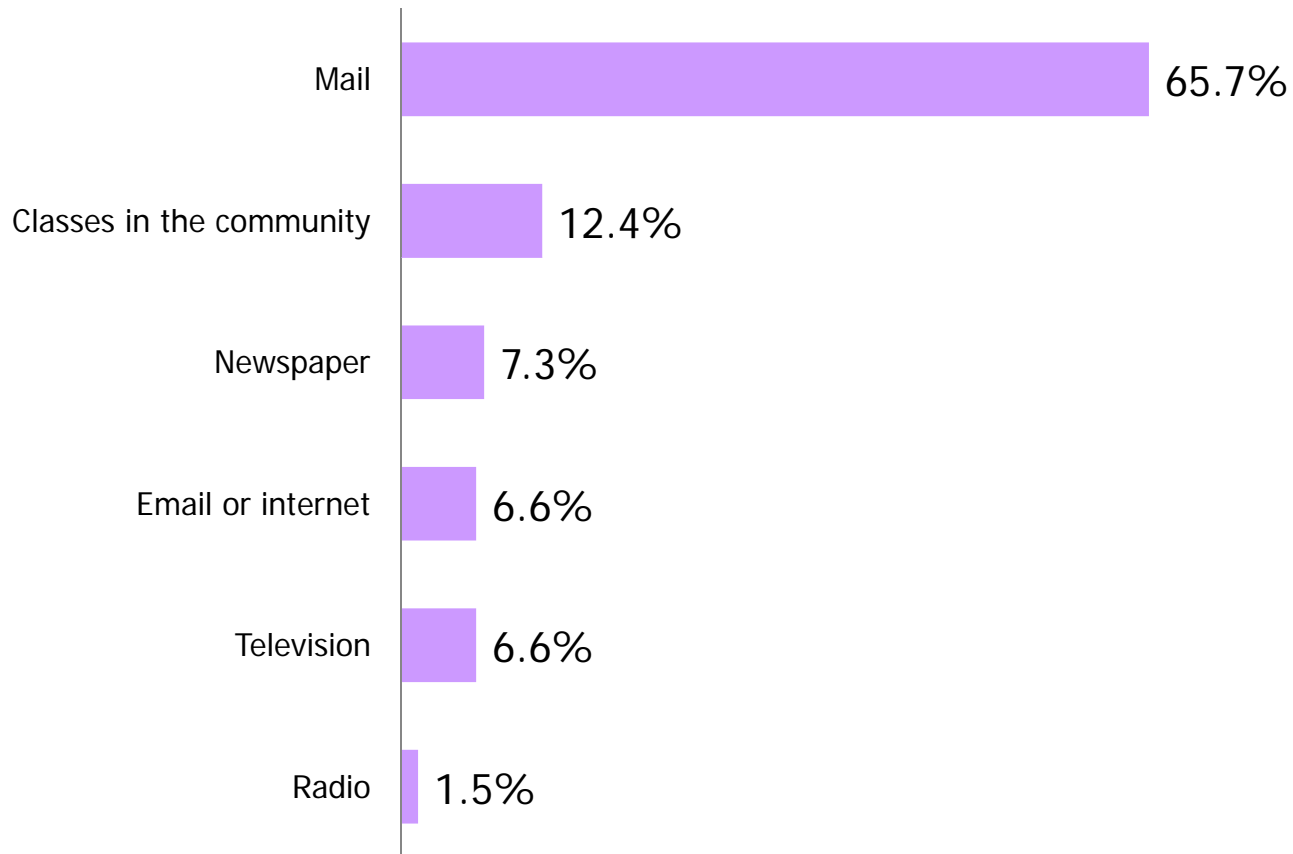
# Child Abuse Victim Rate per 1000 Children: 2009-2011
