



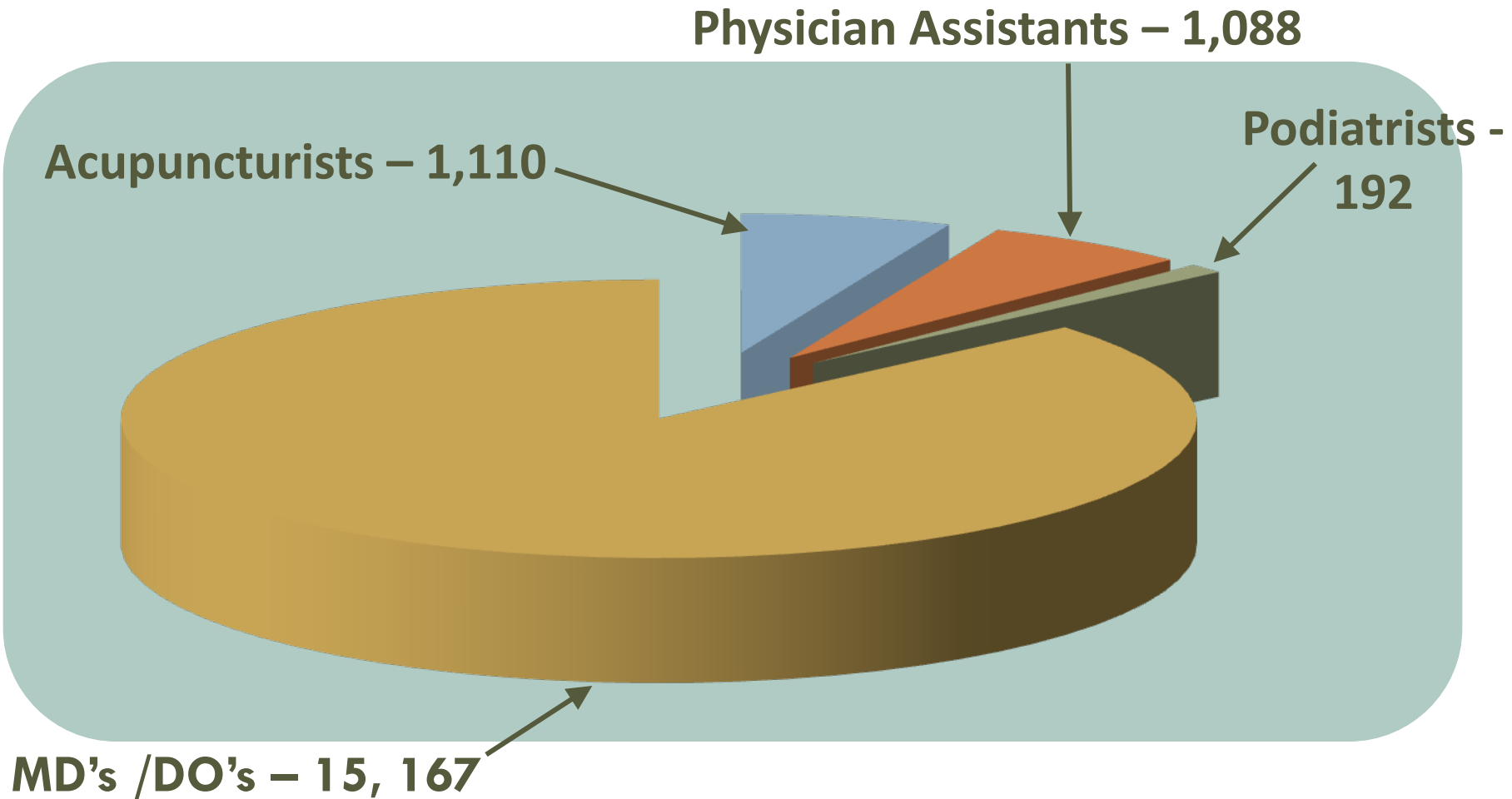

- Serve a one 3-year term, with the possibility of a second term
- Represents each federal congressional district
- Must be a resident of the state
 - ▣ Medically licensed members must have been in practice for at least five years immediately preceding their term

Information current as of December 31, 2010

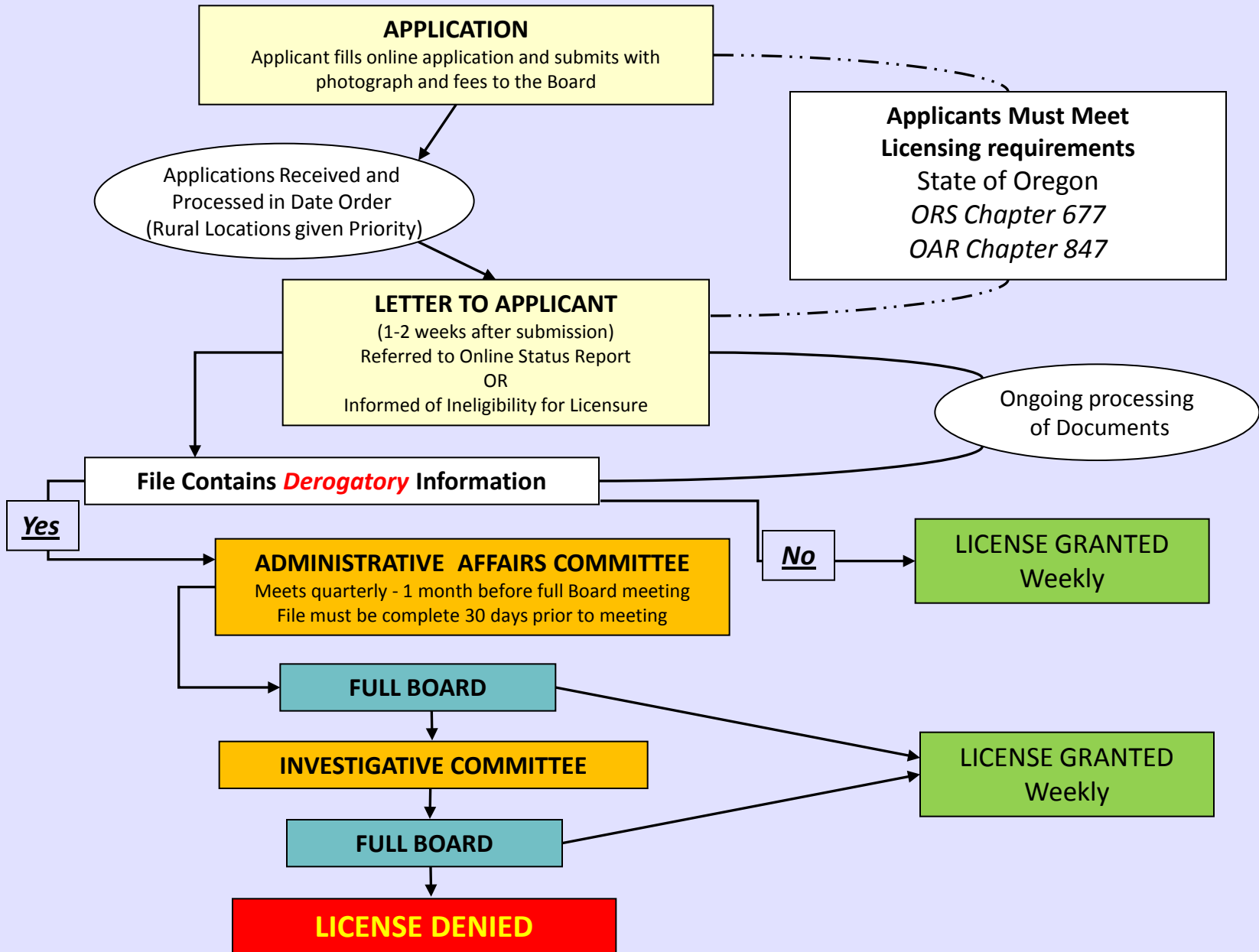




The licensing process is the first step in promoting quality care – through physician competence.

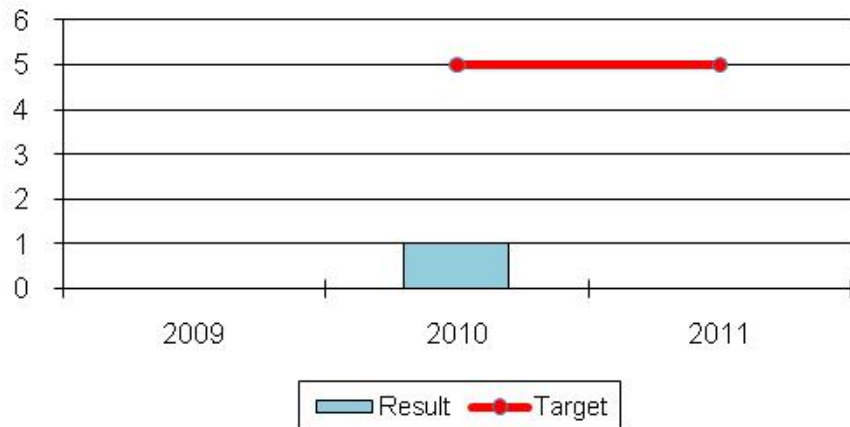

OREGON MEDICAL BOARD - LICENSING PROCESS

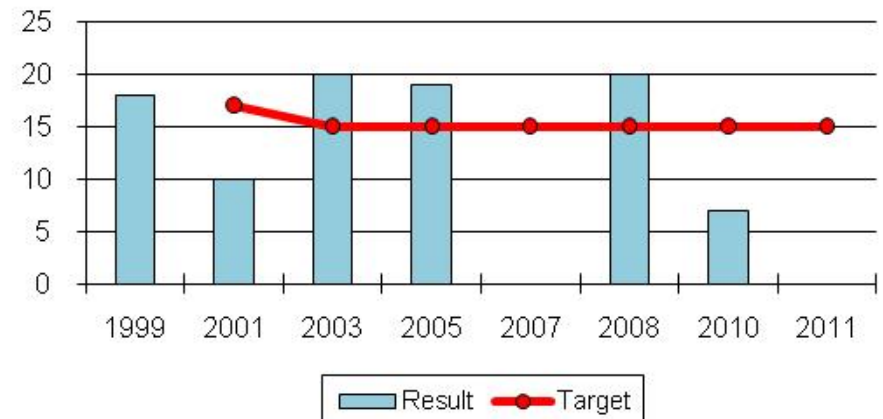


Licensing Services - Performance Measures

- July 1, 2010 start date
- Monitoring not treatment
- Reliant Behavioral Health
- Federal confidentiality applies

Eligibility

- Evaluation and diagnosis by an independent, third party evaluator approved by the Board.
- Enter into the “HPSP Monitoring Agreement”
- “Safe to Practice” Investigation upon enrollment

Entrance to Program

- Self Referral
- Board Referral
- Provisional Enrollment

Licensee Responsibilities

- Abstain from mind altering drugs, intoxicating substances or potentially addictive drugs
- Participate in an approved treatment plan and required meetings
- Limit practice, if necessary
- Submit to random drug and alcohol testing
- Agree to report and be responsible for costs

Patient Safety Begins with YOU!

If you have cause to believe another health care professional has information that a licensee is or may be medically incompetent, guilty of improper conduct or physical incapacity, you must report!

Institutional Responsibility

*Any licensed healthcare facility must report
'OFFICIAL ACTIONS'*

ORS 676.150 clearly spells out, in detail, those reporting obligations.



High Level Accomplishments

- *Each of the nine Key Performance Measures met or exceeded*
- *Over 1,000,000 visits to the OMB website*
- *More than 1,000 new health care providers licensed*
- *Practitioners received a license within one business day upon completion of the application*
- *Complaint Resource Officer answered over 2,400 phone call inquiries*
