The Health and Human Services (HHS) regulations for the protection of human subjects (45 CFR part 46) subpart E requires Institutional Review Boards (IRBs) that review human subjects research conducted or supported by HHS and that are designated under an assurance of compliance approved for federalwide use by the Office for Human Research Protections (OHRP) to register with HHS.

The IRBs of the Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU) are all registered with OHRP. The following are the registration numbers for each of the four OHSU IRBs:

OHSU's Federalwide assurance number is FWA00000161 and is current with an expiration date of July 23, 2013.

The registration information includes contact information, approximate numbers of all active protocols and active protocols involving research conducted or supported by HHS, and staffing for the IRB.

The IRB registration system is compatible with the IRB registration requirements of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), allowing the operation of a single HHS IRB registration system.
