Industry Clinical Trial Budgets (or “How Not to Lose Your Shirt”)

- Budgets are negotiable
- A company’s budget may not cover your costs
 - You must know your costs, including required fees (IRB fees, Research Pharmacy, correct F&A, etc.)
 - You must make sure that what is being offered covers your costs
 - If it doesn’t cover your costs, ask for what you need
- Payment schedules also matter
 - Ask for money up front (start-up costs)
 - OHSU may end up fronting large sums of money for the company
 - You may not get paid for what you do
 - It may take a long time to get paid for what you do
- If you can’t make enrollment, you may lose money
