**ANNOUNCING THE 2009 ONPRC SUMMER FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM
FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS**

The Oregon National Primate Research Center invites college undergraduates who are interested in neuroscience or reproductive sciences to apply for the ONPRC Summer Fellowship Program. Applicants selected to participate in this 8-week program will receive a \$2000 stipend and assistance with travel expenses (out of state residents).

Principal Investigators in the Divisions of Neuroscience and Reproductive Sciences oversee research programs that relate to high-priority medical needs that are expected to increase in importance and funding emphasis over the coming decades. These include research in neurodevelopment, neuroendocrinology, neurodegeneration, cancer, aging, mental illness, brain injury, addiction, obesity, reproductive health, and stem cells.

The Summer Fellowship Program for Undergraduates seeks qualified applicants who will enter either their junior or senior year of college in the Fall of 2009. Selected applicants will work as part of a research team in an established laboratory alongside a staff member whose research interests complement the student's own. A special summer seminar series, weekly lab meetings, journal clubs, and access to other laboratories at the Center combine to make this program a comprehensive, creative and accelerated learning experience.
