Course Description

The 5-credit capstone course sequence (2 credits in winter, 3 credits in spring) provides students with valuable professional experience as they address a real-world business problem posed by a participating healthcare organization that serves as the project sponsor.

Students collaborate in teams, developing their analysis and recommendations to complete the project. The teams then prepare a final report and conduct a presentation to the participating project sponsor. In the capstone course, students are expected to integrate prior learning, seek opportunities to reinforce areas of weakness, and acquire new knowledge to complete the project successfully.
