

Resident Parking Permits

Each year, Graduate Medical Education provides a list to Transportation & Parking of people eligible for resident parking options:

- **Annual Marquam Hill:** 2 Diamond parking permit.
- **Annual South Waterfront:** 3 Diamond Schnitzer lot parking permit.
- **Monthly or quarterly parking** is convenient for residents with intermittent OHSU rotations.
- **Daily:** Visit www.ohsu.edu/parking for daily parking options.

Please review your rotation schedules prior to signing up for parking to best select the option that meets your needs. To sign up for parking:

- Visit ohsu.edu/parking. Click on the Online Parking Account link.
- Log in with your OHSU username and email.
- Select *Buy Monthly/Annual Permit* then the option that suits your needs.

Annual permits must be paid through pre-tax payroll deduction. Annual permits begin July 1st and expire the next year on June 30th. You may register up to 3 vehicles on your permit. Only 1 vehicle may be on campus at a time.

If you select the annual permit option, deductions will appear on your next paycheck. You may stop and restart payroll deduction one time before the end of the Academic Year.

- To stop deductions, email parking@ohsu.edu. Include your restart date if known. You will receive email confirmation of when deductions will stop.
- If you do not know when you would like to restart your parking, email parking@ohsu.edu once you know that date. You will receive confirmation of when deductions will restart.
- Your hangtag is not active until you have received email confirmation that payroll deductions have begun. Until your permit is active, parking on campus requires purchasing daily parking.

Monthly or Quarterly Permit: You may register a maximum of three vehicles on your permit. The online account accepts card payment only. Transportation & Parking Customer Service also accepts cash or check.

The OHSU Bike Program includes a variety of facilities, cash-for-biking, and trip tracking. At South Waterfront, our partner **Go By Bike** (gobybikepdx.com) offers free valet protection, loaner bikes, and professional repair. Marquam Hill's **Student Center** has a self-repair station, lockers, and showers (ohsu.edu/studentcenter). Anywhere but the valet, secure your frame to a rack using a U-lock.



OHSU Shuttle

Marquam Hill Shuttle travels downtown every 30 minutes, 7am-5pm. **South Waterfront Shuttle** runs every 10 minutes between OHSU facilities, 5:30am-9:30pm. The streetcar also follows the Waterfront shuttle route.

Portland Aerial Tram

The tram travels from the lower terminal at **South Waterfront** (SW Moody Ave & Gibbs St) to **Marquam Hill** (OHSU Kohler Pavilion) in 5 minutes. The tram operates on a load-n-go schedule.

Weekdays, 5:30am-9:30pm. Saturday, 9am-5pm. Sunday varies by season. Closed on OHSU-observed holidays.

Portland Streetcar

OHSU pays for your ride along the whole streetcar system. **The NS Line** connects **NW Portland, downtown**, and **South Waterfront**. Connect to **Marquam Hill** via the tram. Plan your trip via TriMet apps. CS Line does not service South Waterfront.

Weekdays: 1st arrival (Stop 12760), 5:52 a.m.; last departure (Stop 12883), 12:10 a.m.

Transit

Portland regional transit: **TriMet** (ride.trimet.org); Vancouver: **C-Tran** (c-tran.com). Plan a trip online and via apps (**PDX Bus**, **Google Maps**). Include arrival time in the trip planner as our 6 **express lines** only run at morning/evening rush.

All Portland public transit, including the aerial tram, is **ADA accessible**. Bring your OHSU badge to our Customer Service to purchase a subsidized pass.

Park & Rides: free parking 24/7; 64 locations at trimet.org/parkandride.

Marquam Hill service: TriMet Line **8** is frequent service. **61, 64, 65, 66, 68** and **C-Tran 190** to are express lines (morning/afternoon rush only).

OHSU Hospital: Stop ID 5028. Weekdays: 1st arrival, 5:52am; last departure, 12:10am.

South Waterfront service: Lines **35, 36** and **Streetcar NS Line**. Access **1, 9, 12, 17, 19, 38, 43, 44, 45, 55**, and **56** via Gibbs Street Pedestrian Bridge.
