Purpose

To control access to the Research Courtyard in order to ensure pedestrian safety and compliance with traffic weight restrictions.

Definitions

Research Courtyard - The open area which is accessible from Richard Jones Hall Addition, Richard Jones Hall, Vollum, Medical Research Building, Mackenzie Hall and the OHSU Auditorium. Access into the area is gained from behind the OHSU Auditorium, beyond the bollards.

Procedure

The Research Courtyard is a pedestrian-safe zone where vehicle and powered cart access is restricted. Normal traffic is restricted through the use of locking traffic bollards.

The following categories are exempt from this restriction:

- Emergency vehicles responding to an emergency,
- Snow removal equipment during inclement weather (as directed by the Snow Boss, or when the Inclement Weather Policy is in effect),
- Small Facilities & Logistics maintenance or grounds-keeping vehicles.

Enforcement

Non-exempt vehicles that gain access into the Research Courtyard without an exception from Transportation & Parking will be subject to ticketing and/or towing at the vehicle owner's expense.
