

What is TWH?


Total Worker Health (TWH) TM is a strategy for integrating

- traditional occupational safety and health programs (OSH) (aka, Health Protection)
- with Health Promotion (HP)
 because the causes of occupational injuries and illnesses are multi-factorial and inter-related, and the causes of many chronic diseases are multi-factorial and inter-related
