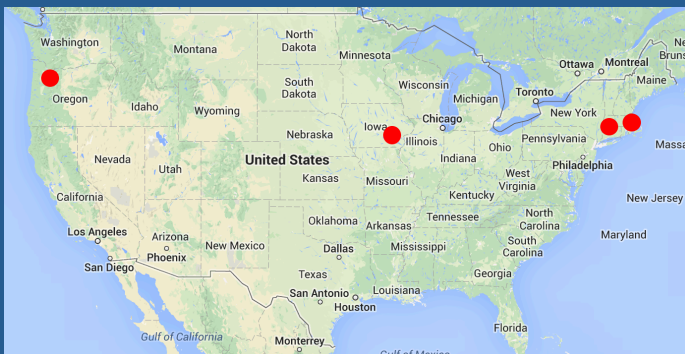

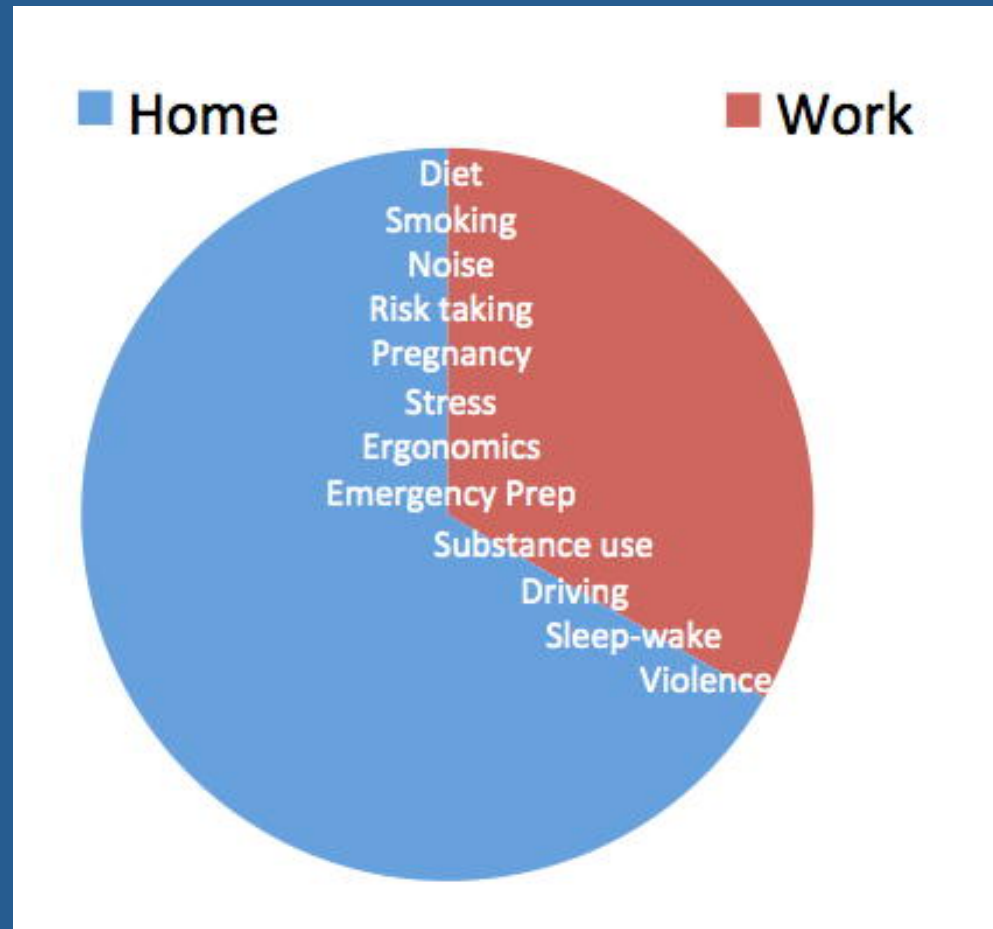


OHWC is about TWH Interventions

- Today's meeting is about partnering with Oregon industry, government, labor to build a dissemination program to reach throughout Oregon – this is not planned in nor funded by the grant

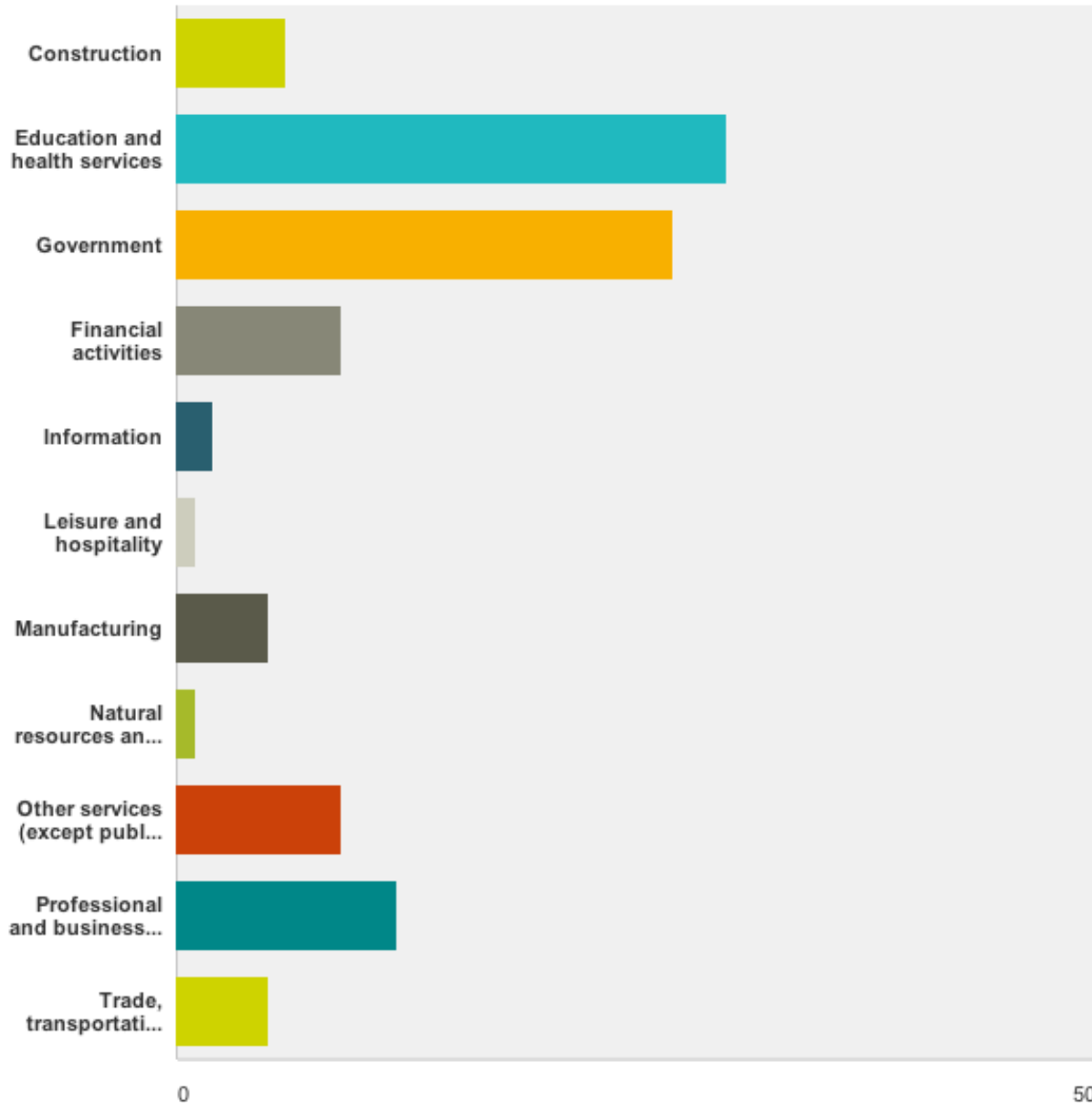
What is TWH?

- Total Worker Health (TWH)TM** is a strategy for integrating
- traditional occupational safety and health programs (OSH) (aka, Health Protection)
 - with Health Promotion (HP)
- because the causes of occupational injuries and illnesses are multi-factorial and inter-related, and the causes of many chronic diseases are multi-factorial and inter-related
