"(b) Each research facility shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include:

(2) The use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries, and the availability of emergency, weekend, and holiday care;"

Treatment areas in four animal buildings had some recently expired drugs on the shelves. Expired drugs were removed by the attending vet at the time of inspection.

The registrant states that they will circulate a memo to correct this noncompliant item today, February 8, 2006.

Inspection conducted February 7-8, 2006.

This report was conducted over a two day period (February 7-8, 2006).

One item identified:
The USDA noted some drugs that had expired just days before the inspection. OHSU's timeline for checking medications was shifted to prevent this from happening.
