

# The CART Research Study

Participate in a study exploring how technology supports the aging process

## You may be eligible if you:

- Live independently or with a partner
- Live in section 202 housing or meet certain income requirements
- Are at least 62 years old

## What is Involved:

- Continuous measurement of activity patterns, by using motion sensors placed in your home and devices like a digital watch, scale and pillbox.
- In-home cognitive assessments
- \$49 monthly stipend to offset Internet access costs at home



The Collaborative Aging (in Place) Research using Technology (CART) project uses technology to assess activity in a home, with the hope of helping people remain independent as they age. By participating in this three-year long study, you'll be contributing to the development of future devices that aim to increase the quality of life of older adults.
