OHSU policy states all students accepted to education programs with a clinical component must successfully pass an initial drug screening. The policy was established to promote the health, safety, and productivity of students and patients in their care. In addition, successfully passing a drug test is a requirement of attendance and is an acceptance contingency as stated in your initial acceptance offer letter. Incoming students who refuse to submit to or do not pass the drug screening may have their admission rescinded. The drug testing program consists of pre-clinical experience testing of students and 'for cause' testing for any student suspected of being under the influence of unlawful drugs or alcohol during their course of study. Potential 'for cause' testing will occur as deemed necessary and may include urine testing for unlawful drugs, and breath or blood testing for alcohol.

Testing will be available between May 1 and June 15, 2019. Incoming PA students are required to complete a drug test at an authorized collection site within the specified timeframe. If you currently do not reside in the Portland-metro area, the drug testing company (A WorkSAFE Service, Inc.) will contact you regarding location options in your area.

Please be aware that drug and alcohol test results will be considered confidential as required by federal and state law and may only be reviewed by OHSU officials and affiliated clinical facilities in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Drug and alcohol testing reports and any submitted health information of students shall be maintained at OHSU in accordance with the OHSU record retention policies for student records.

The 10 panel drug test being administered tests for a variety of substances including, but not limited to, amphetamines, cocaine, marijuana, opiates, barbiturates, and methadone. **While many states, including Oregon, have legalized the use of marijuana, OHSU continues to consider marijuana an illegal substance in adherence with current federal law.**

Be advised that OHSU students from other departments will be using these locations, so there may be sites with longer wait times. Contact Colleen Schierholtz schierhc@ohsu.edu if you have any questions.

Instructions for Student Testing:

- Fill out the **Legacy MetroLab Drug Test Registration form** with name, date, & University ID number
- The cost is for the drug screen is **\$44.00 (OR) \$49.00 (out of state) payable prior** to submitting for the test. Unfortunately **payment is not accepted at the actual site**, so students **will need to pay ahead of their test date/time**.
 - Payment by visa/mastercard/debit is the preferred method. You can call A WorkSAFE, Inc., at 888-391-9363, identify yourself as an OHSU PA student and pay over the phone.
 - If you'd prefer to pay by check, please make the check payable to A WorkSAFE, Inc., be sure your full name is on the check, and mail the check to A WorkSAFE, Inc., 1696 Capitol St NE, Salem, OR 97301.
- **Print a copy** of the form; **bring it with you to the designated collection site** within the dates listed above (no need to make an appointment)
- **Bring Government Photo ID** with you (OHSU student badge is not required)
- Allow at least 30 minutes for your appointment
- The last testing appointment is scheduled a minimum of 30 minutes before the site closes
- Lines are generally shorter in the morning but depends on how many others are waiting to be tested
- Avoid drinking excessive amounts of liquids (it will dilute the sample and another test will be required)
- You will only be contacted if there is a problem with your sample (**you may assume your test was negative if you are not contacted for an additional test**)
