The OHSU Guest House—to be known as the Gary & Christine Rood Family Pavilion, will serve as a welcoming home-away-from-home dedicated to serving 49% of Doernbecher's patient population who are traveling from long distances to receive care at Doernbecher Children's Hospital and the Knight Cancer Institute. The guest house will also be a part of our world-class cancer facility for patients traveling to OHSU for clinical trials and clinical research programs.
