

Intro to Surgery I (SURG 705B)

Elective Requirements

In order to receive 1 credit for the *Intro to Surgery (SURG 705B)* elective, the student must complete *all of the following*. Please print out the second page and complete a short description listing specific details of events (surgical case seen/presented, volunteer function, VirtuOHSU lab procedure, etc.), and receive required signatures for each. Completed forms are to be turned in to Marci Jo Carlton, Medical Student Coordinator (Mac Hall 3168). Last day to turn in forms is Friday, May 30th.

Suture Workshop: Faculty preceptor: Dr. Slate Wilson

A month-long suture and knot tying skills course, held 4 consecutive Thursdays from 1200-1300. There is a required fee of \$15 for this workshop that will cover the supplies.

- If paying by check or cash, you will need to pay on the first day of the Suture Workshop. Please make checks out to the "OHSU Foundation".

Virtual Lab or Lecture Series:

- Virtual Labs: These are held in the VirtuOHSU lab in the old library. Students must attend at least *one* session.
- Lecture Series: These are lectures given by surgery attendings/faculty, residency directors, clerkship advisors, etc. about how to best prepare for, and what to expect, as you approach surgery as a medical student and beyond. OR Time:

You will need to observe at least *two operations* for a grand total of *four hours* (at least 2 hours in each). Signatures must be received from the attending physician or resident involved in the case.

M&M Conference:

Attend at least *one* surgical morbidity and mortality conference. These are held on Monday mornings at 0645 in the Old Library Auditorium.

Surgery Grand Rounds or Trauma Conference:

Attend at least *one* Surgery Grand Rounds...*or*...Trauma Conference. The time and locations are as follows:

- Grand Rounds are on Monday mornings at 0730 in the Old Library Auditorium.
- Trauma Conference are on Wednesday mornings at 0700 in Doernbecher Children's Hospital, Marion Miller Auditorium, 11th floor #11620.

Volunteering:

You will need to volunteer at *two* SIG related events. This may include: VirtuOHSU labs held for visiting middle, high school, and college students. You may also do suturing workshops hosted at PSU, etc. See Sakai calendar for specific dates and details.
