### Table notes

#### a. Sex Offenses, (NIBRS)

**Forcible** - Any sexual act directed against another person, without the consent of the victim including instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent. Including, **Forcible Fondling** - The touching of the private body parts of another person for the purposes of sexual gratification, forcible and/or against that person's will or not forcible or against that person's will in instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her youth or because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity. Including forcible fondling, defined below.

**Forcible Fondling** - The touching of the private body parts of another person for the purposes of sexual gratification, forcible and/or against that person's will or not forcible or against that person's will in instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her youth or because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

#### b. Sex Offenses, (NIBRS)

**Nonforcible** - (Except Prostitution Offenses) Unlawful, non forcible sexual intercourse includes incest and statutory rape (both defined below.)

**Incent** - Nonforcible sexual intercourse between persons who are related to each other within the degrees wherein marriage is prohibited by law.

**Statutory Rape** - Nonforcible sexual intercourse with a person who is under the statutory age of consent.

c. Liquor Law Violations and Illegal Weapons Possession Violations Referred to Disciplinary Actions – the number of persons referred for disciplinary action does not include persons arrest and reported in the arrest categories above.

d. Hate Crimes – Criminal offenses committed against a person or property which is motivated in whole or in part, by the offender's bias. The bias categories are: race, gender, gender identity, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity, national origin, or disability.

**Note:** Definitions in regards to Sex Offenses (both forcible and nonforcible) are from the FBI's National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). All other crime definitions are from the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program. Use of these specific definitions meets the Clery Act requirements for crime definitions.
