OUR PARTNERS

As evaluators, we work in partnership with researchers, organization staff, and intervention participants to measure and communicate program efficacy. We also collaborate with and provide referrals to OHSU programs including the Community Research Hub, Biostatistics and Design Program, Clinical Research Informatics, Library, and BUILD EXITO.

OUR WORK

The Evaluation Core provides consultation, training, ongoing technical assistance, and services covering the following topics:

- Design and implementation of evaluation plans across a continuum of intervention types and settings
- Development of logic models, project objectives, research productivity metrics, and outcome measures including SMART goals
- Selection and design of measurement instruments, including surveys and focus group/interview protocols
- Collection and analysis of qualitative and quantitative data
- Selection of developmentally- and culturally-aligned evaluation approaches
- Design and measurement of implementation and sustainability outcomes
- Development of communication and dissemination strategies, supporting the translation of research into practice
