

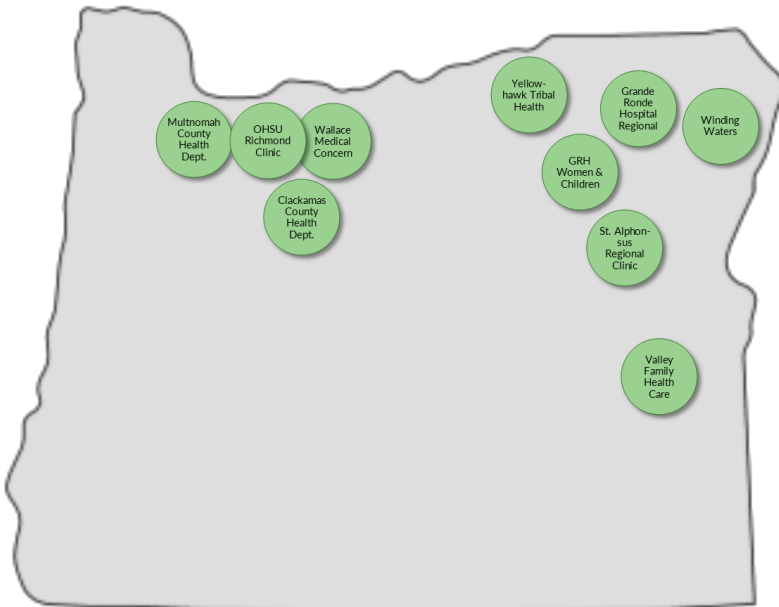
OPACT | Oregon Primary Care Transformation

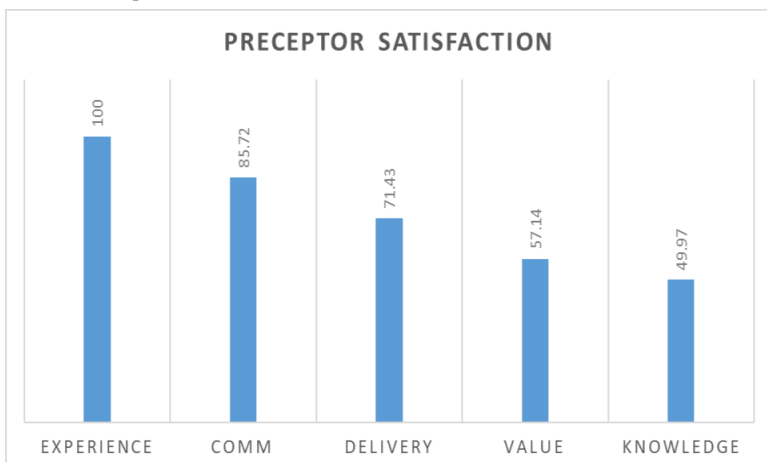
Accomplishments—Year One

Clinical Partnership



OPACT clinical partners include 10 clinics in 7 Oregon counties serving rural and underserved populations.

Registered Nurse clinical preceptors reported 100% satisfaction with the overall OPACT clinical experience and identified important areas of focus for year two:

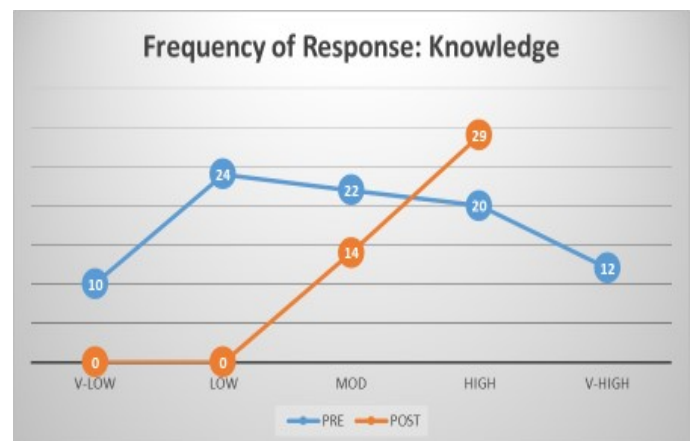
- Program communication and delivery

Clinical Experience



Nineteen undergraduate nursing students received a total of 3,450 hours of clinical experience in primary care.

Student Knowledge



The majority (70%) of students reported an increase in knowledge about RN roles in:

- Care coordination
- Integration
- Continuity of care
