

Membership and Usage

The Student Center offers recreational membership options to OHSU campus members and guests, but its primary purpose is to provide current OHSU students with extracurricular opportunities and grant them priority access to the facility.

Membership and access requirements include:

- Individuals must have a current OHSU ID badge or purchase a preloaded access card (with \$20 minimum) to utilize the facility.
 - a) Enrolled OHSU Students - must present a current ID Badge;
 - b) OHSU residents and fellows in registered GME program - must present an access card made available by GME. Sign-up for your card at the Student Center front desk;
 - c) Significant others of OHSU students and GME residents/fellows - must present an access card to enjoy access at a discounted rate. Please note that the students and GME residents/fellows must be present - with their valid OHSU ID badge - at the time of their significant other's sign-up;
 - d) OHSU employees must purchase an access card or sign-up for payroll deduction;
 - e) Visiting students, faculty, volunteers, and guests must purchase a preloaded access card;
- Access cards must be present and have available funds. If the card has a zero balance, it must be re-loaded with the \$20 minimum at the time of service;
- Daily drop-in fees or one-time use fees are not available at the Student Center;
- Each patron must sign-up for their own access card;
- Access cards are non-transferable, non-refundable and offer no cash back;
- Access cards are valid for services and products offered by the Student Center and Campus Store;
- Access cards do not expire;
- If lost, an access card can be replaced for a fee.

The Student Center has daily use lockers available, but individuals need to provide their own lock. We also have baskets and bike lockers with pre-assigned locks available for rent.
