Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19): Perspective of 2 Infectious Disease Physicians

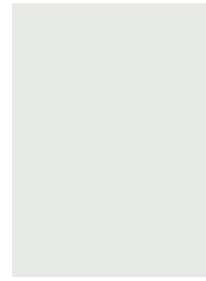
NEXT WEEK Tuesday, June 9 2:00 - 3:00 pm CST

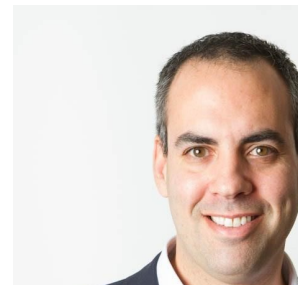
