Investigators applying for a small business innovation research or small business technology transfer research (SBIR/STTR) grant receive valuable feedback during proposal development to enhance their proposal's competitiveness.

Experts in SBIR/STTR, including study section review, the NIH and NSF process, and successful award recipients are invited to listen to a short presentation of your proposal to ask questions and provide feedback on your commercialization strategy and opportunity, research approach, feasibility assessment and overall readiness, among other critical review components.

- Informal, verbal feedback. Proposals do not have to be drafted in order to participate.
