WHO IS ELIGIBLE

The goal of the OHSU Fellowship for Diversity in Research (OFDIR) is **to increase the representation of minoritized races and ethnicities in STEM at the postdoctoral level.**

You are eligible for this Fellowship if you identify as a member of an underrepresented racial group and are seeking postdoctoral training to advance your research career.

HOW TO APPLY

To apply, you need to:

- 1) **Connect with an OHSU faculty member** to be your hiring PI and mentor
- 2) **Apply online** (the following are needed)
 - Curriculum vitae/resume
 - Two letters of reference
 - Letter of support from OHSU mentor
 - Personal statement
 - Research plan
- 3) **Interview** (finalists will interview by Skype)
