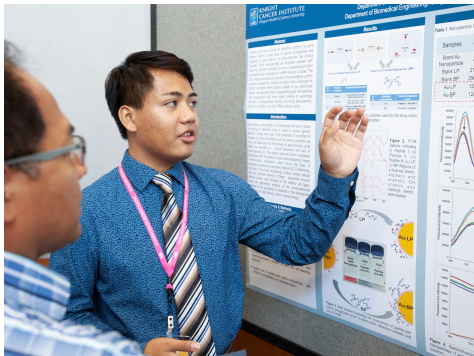


Ted R. Lilley Cancer CURE Program

- Students must have a 3.0 GPA or higher, have taken at least one science class (preferably biology), have an interest in research
