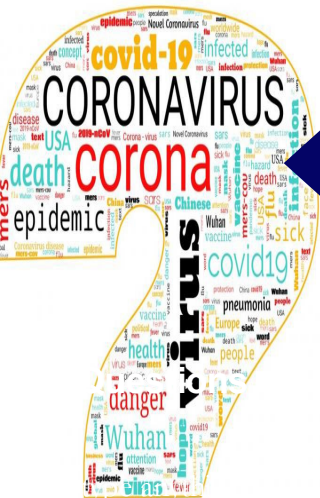

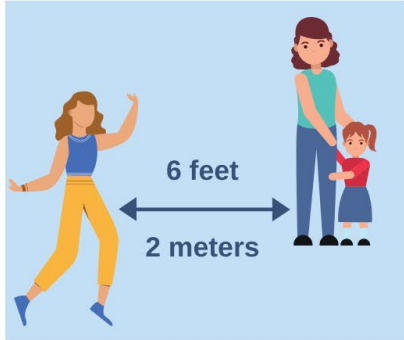

HELP SLOW THE SPREAD



Limiting contact with others ensures we have resources we need them. Slowing the spread of the virus helps ensure supplies for the most critical needs. PRACTICE THE 3 C'S



CLEAN your hands frequently, washing for 20 seconds with soap and warm water.

KNOW WHEN TO SEEK CARE



If you have mild symptoms or believe you've been exposed, stay home. If you feel worse or have a fever with cough or shortness of breath, call your primary care physician.
