

OHSU NETWORK PERFORMANCE AT A GLANCE

On Nov 5, we had 59 subjects enrolled across all studies through our network. Thanks to your OUTSTANDING efforts, we now have **110 subjects** enrolled. Not only have our sites enrolled the most subjects of ANY other Award Hub network, we also rank #1 in subject retention; #3 in regulatory document collection (94% completed), and #1 in Case Report Form Collection. Kudos to every team member at each and every site for this performance track record.

COMPETITIVE GRANT RENEWAL FOR SIREN COMING IN '21

Later this year, the NIH announcement and details surrounding the SIREN network competitive renewal process is expected. Given the success of the network we have built to date, we are hopeful that each of our current sites will chose to continue to partner with us. However, we understand that you may also wish to apply as a separate award Hub network. As we learn more about this next funding cycle, please keep us informed about your plans, and we will keep you updated on our Hub renewal application. . We have been advised that the CCC and DCC will be automatically renewed while Hub renewal will follow a competitive process. The SIREN network is hoping to expand from 11 to 14 Hubs and have also requested funds to help train future researchers for the network.

BOOST 3 NEWS & UPDATES

- BOOST 3 enrollments: 90 (Target enrollment 1094)
- **OHSU Network Enrollment: 33 (27% of total enrolled subjects)**
- Kudos to URMC and Utah who continue to be high enrollers in BOOST 3, currently sitting at 3rd and 4th place!
- URMC and OHSU are participating in BioBOOST
 - OHSU has received BioBOOST kits and URMC is currently waiting for kit to arrive. Stay tuned for lessons learned once one of our sites enroll a subject.

Two Trial surveys to expect soon

Ketosis (<https://siren.network/clinical-trials/ketosis>) – a Status Epilepticus study that will be resubmitted for review and funding

EPIC2 – This is a TBI trial that will also be releasing a survey of interest/ability soon. Dr. Wang is expecting to submit this study in June for review and funding consideration.
