



How to prepare for your shift at Multnomah Pavilion COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic

What to wear

- Mask.
- Clinical roles: Scrubs
- Non-clinical roles: Business casual
- No fragrance or open-toed shoes.

Before you arrive

Please ensure you have no illness or symptoms prior to volunteering. If you need to cancel due to illness, please see the link at the bottom of the page.

Arrival time

Please arrive with enough time to park and be at the OHSU check-in located in the Multnomah Pavilion second floor lobby, by the beginning of your shift.

Where to park

Parking is available in the OHSU parking lots and is free of charge on the weekend.

Check in/Check out for your shift

Check in/out at the OHSU Check-In station in the Multnomah Pavilion second floor lobby for your assignment. You will receive a temporary ID badge and instructions from the clinic lead.

No photo taking permitted on site

While we realize it can be exciting to share your role in getting Oregonians vaccinated, to protect patient privacy and restricted information, please do not take ANY photos on site at the vaccine clinic. Any photographers you may see have been pre-approved by vaccine site management.
