



OHSU COVID-19 vaccination volunteer roles and qualifications for external volunteers

NON-CLINICAL		
ROLE	FUNCTION	WHO IS ELIGIBLE?
Greeting, traffic and flow	Greeting vehicles as they arrive and cross checking a list to make sure they have an appointment	Open to all registered volunteers
Registration and check-in	Primary role is to register patients, set up patient with MyChart account, and verifying phone, address and email	PAS, MA or those who have completed OHSU EHR training or have previous EHR experience
Vaccine supply support/runner	Primary function is to take the syringes from pharmacy to the vaccinators	Open to all registered volunteers
Wait monitor (non-clinical)	Primary function is to assist the clinical wait monitor	Open to all registered volunteers

ROLE	FUNCTION	WHO IS ELIGIBLE?
Wait monitor (clinical)	Primary function is to engage with and monitor patients post vaccination for adverse reaction while they are waiting their 15 or 30 minutes in their vehicles. Bring own stethoscope.	MA, LPN, RN or other license
Vaccine administration	Primary function is collect patient reported data, determine appropriateness for testing and/or vaccination based on delegated protocol, place order, and perform specimen collection and/or vaccination	MD, DO, PA, EMT, RN, LPN, dentists, naturopaths, pharmacists, pharmacy technicians or other license to give vaccines in Oregon

Site physical conditions

PDX = excessive noise, outdoors, primarily standing

OCC = large site, may need to quickly navigate long distances, excessive background noise

Scappoose = indoor/outdoor, clinical environment
