



Brent Burton, M.D., M.P.H.

Brent T. Burton, MD, MPH is a private practice Consulting Medical Toxicologist with board certification in Medical Toxicology, Occupational Medicine and Emergency Medicine. He has provided forensic toxicology consulting services for more than 30 years and has conducted more than 3000 toxicology patient evaluations. Dr. Burton graduated from the University of Utah with a BA in psychology in 1974 and MD in 1978. He completed emergency medicine training at Oregon Health and Sciences University (OHSU) and joined the faculty in 1981. He later took a sabbatical to attend the University of Washington and was awarded a Masters in Public Health. During his career at OHSU, Dr. Burton was the Medical Director for the Oregon Poison Center and founded a Medical Toxicology Fellowship Training Program. He also chaired the Pharmacy & Therapeutics Committee and was the Medical Director of the Occupational Health Program. He has also held elected positions in the AAPCC and the NW Chapter of ACOEM. Dr. Burton has volunteered his expertise in toxicology by serving on several hospital and public committees for issues that include water quality, drugs and alcohol, poison prevention, meth labs, and environmental cleanup standards.
