Patients receiving the following therapies may qualify for the HIT Benefit if they meet medical-necessity criteria as outlined by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS):

- Certain antiviral and antifungal medications
- Deferoxamine
- Certain pain therapies
- Inotropes for heart failure
- Subcutaneous Immune Globulin therapy
- Certain chemotherapy medications
