

Behavioral and Systems Neuroscience Graduate Program Rotation Approval | 2021/22 Academic Year

The purpose of this form is to clearly define expectations among graduate students, rotation advisors, program directors and primary administrative units with respect to graduate student rotations. Research rotations provide a necessary first step in determining where each first year graduate student will conduct their dissertation research. They also provide an opportunity for students to learn about research environments and approaches that differ from that of their chosen lab. At the end of the rotation, the rotation advisor is expected to provide a firm "yes" or "no" as to whether they would accept the student in their lab.

Completion of this form **does not** obligate a rotation advisor to take the student into the lab once the rotation is complete.
