Policy Title: Faculty Enrollment in Degree/Certificate Programs

1. Policy Statement

It is desirable for OHSU School of Nursing (SON) faculty to advance their learning and obtain additional academic degree(s) or specialty credential(s). Therefore, SON faculty, defined as a full- or part-time SON employee who holds faculty rank of lecturer, instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, or professor may apply for admission to SON degree/certificate programs.

If accepted for admission, individual faculty, his/her supervising faculty, and the director of the program in which the faculty plans to matriculate must agree that there are no apparent conflicts of interest or work load commitments. A documented management plan must be developed if a conflict(s) is identified.

- While enrolled in a SON degree/certificate program: Faculty members may not be faculty of record for courses, provide clinical supervision, or act as a formal academic advisor to students in the program in which the faculty member is enrolled; and
- Faculty members may attend faculty governance council and committee meetings; however, s/he must resign any faculty governance committee or council memberships and related voting rights. Eligibility and voting rights will be re-granted when the faculty member completes the degree/certificate program requirements or is no longer enrolled in the program. Exceptions to this policy can be appealed to the School of Nursing Dean.
