Register account

Eligible OHSU students will automatically have a MyCommute account when starting at OHSU. Log in with your OHSU credentials at ohsu.luum.com.

Programs and Incentives

Trip Plan

Request a plan to see all your options with detailed directions and OHSU resources to save time and money.

Biking/Walking/Scooter

Log each inbound weekday commute trip to earn \$1.50. Free campus bike share, 30 day bike loans, and bike subsidies available to MyCommute members.

Transit

Discounted TriMet and C-TRAN passes may be purchased at our Customer Service Centers. Tram and streetcar are free with an OHSU badge.

Carpool

Use MyCommute to find a long-term carpool partner or OHSU's app-based carpool program to find a match as needed.

Guaranteed Ride Home

Request a free Lyft ride home for personal emergencies. Three rides available per year.

Parking

OHSU is pay to park, weekdays, 8am to 5pm, for any vehicles not arriving for a personal patient appointment.
