



Billable ICD-10-CM Diagnosis Code Sets

Pediatric Z codes for behavioral health can get children and youth behavioral health services that they would otherwise not be eligible to receive.

Please be aware that these pediatric Z codes are covered and billable diagnosis codes. Each of these codes appear on the Oregon Health Authority prioritized list on line 445 or 120.

The Children’s Health Advisory Council (CHAC) recommends universal coverage of behavioral health interventions for young children, including those who do not (yet) have a mental health diagnosis.

Reducing barriers to accessing high quality behavioral health services for young children and their caregivers is central to achieving health equity.

“Advances in science are presenting an increasingly clear picture of how significant adversity in the lives of young children can disrupt the development of the brain and other biological systems. These early disruptions can undermine young children’s opportunities to achieve their full potential. And, while they may be invisible to those who do not experience them, there is no doubt that both systemic racism and interpersonal discrimination can lead to chronic stress activation that imposes significant hardships on families raising young children.”

We recognize that billing with Z codes can be confusing so we have noted on the list below those codes that cannot be billed as a primary diagnosis. The following codes are effective Oct. 1, 2022. You can also find this list posted on our website.
