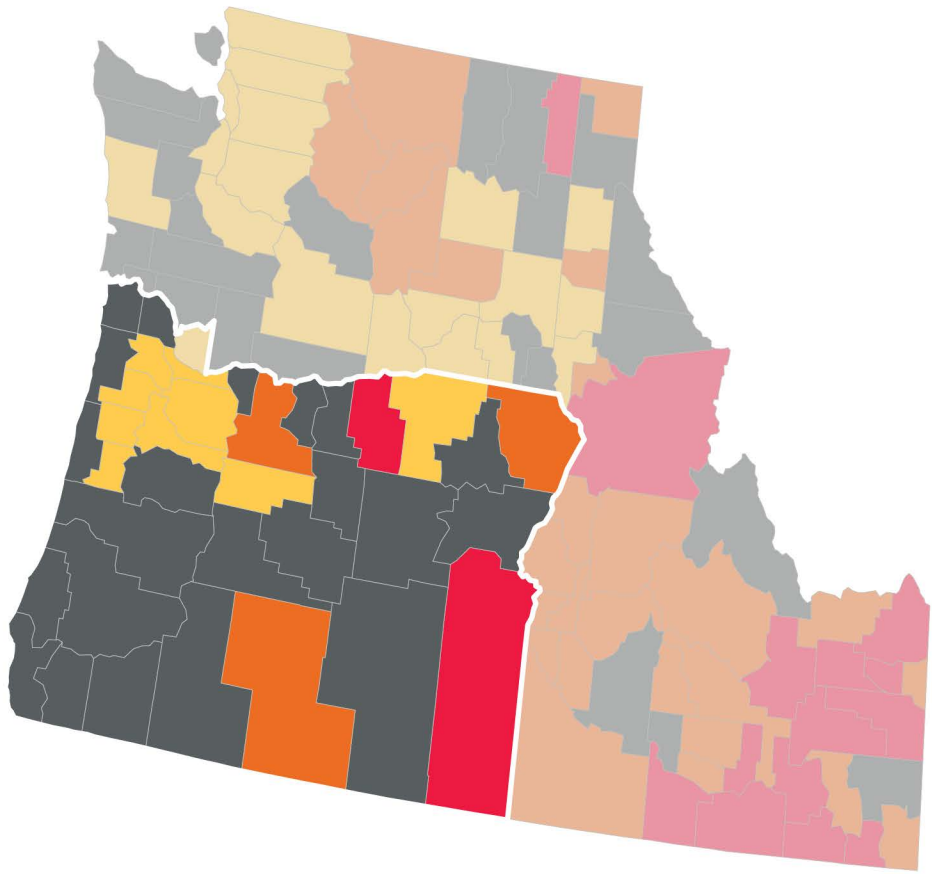


GEOGRAPHIC DISPARITIES IN ABORTION AND CONTRACEPTION ACCESS FOR OREGON MEDICAID RECIPIENTS

- Lowest quartile of contraception, travel distance >50 miles
- Second lowest quartile of contraception, travel distance >50 miles
- Lowest half of contraception, travel distance 50 miles or less
- Top 2 quartiles of contraception



Oregonians from all counties deserve equitable access to comprehensive reproductive healthcare.

An estimated **55,123 Oregonians** live in counties with low contraceptive use, many of whom would need to travel more than 50 miles for abortion care.

Oregon may also see increased demand for abortion services as **38,594 people capable of pregnancy in Idaho's Medicaid** lose access to abortion care.
