- Stipend support from the Oregon Academy of Ophthalmology will prioritize students in the AAO and AUPO's Minority Ophthalmology Mentorship (MOM) program with Oregon residence or non-residence with Oregon heritage (graduated from Oregon high school, college or university, close family living in Oregon, or other ties to Oregon).
- Stipend support from the OHSU Casey Eye Institute will consider all medical students who are underrepresented in medicine accepted into the 4-week elective.
