## **OHSU Kidney Transplant Eligibility Criteria**

## Pediatric Kidney Recipient Eligibility Criteria

- I. Indications for Kidney Transplantation
  - A. End Stage Renal Disease
  - B. Estimated GFR≤ 20cc/min on two sequential determinations
  - C. Significant symptoms or signs of uremia which are unresponsive to oral treatment
- II. Conditions that Increase the Risk of Kidney Transplantation
  - A Psychosocial or financial issues that could result in noncompliance
  - B. Loss of previous kidney graft due to recurrence of medical renal disease within the first week after kidney transplantation
  - C. HIV-positive status
- III. Absolute Contraindications to Kidney Transplantation
  - A. Active infection
  - B. Active malignancy
  - C. Active drug use, alcoholism, or psychosis
  - D. Medical noncompliance
  - E. Anatomy that makes transplantation technically impossible
