OHSU School of Nursing Student Immunization Requirements

REQUIREMENTS	DESCRIPTION
Td series and booster	One Tdap booster done at age 11 years old or later, AND Td booster if last Td- containing vaccine > 10 years ago.
Measles (Rubeola)	Dates of 2 (measles or MMR) vaccines <u>or</u> a positive titer; must submit copy of titer result.
Mumps	Dates of 2 (mumps or MMR) vaccines <u>or</u> a positive titer; must submit copy of titer result.
Rubella	Date of 1 (rubella or MMR) vaccine <u>or</u> a positive titer; must submit copy of titer result.
Hepatitis B	Evidence and dates of series of 3 Hepatitis B vaccines AND a positive Hepatitis B surface antibody titer; must submit copy of titer result. If your surface antibody titer draw ends up being negative, you will need to proceed with getting either the standard 3-dose Hep B vaccination series, or complete the 2-dose Heplisav Hep B vaccination series, and then proceed with getting a new antibody surface titer draw to see if you show immunity.
Varicella	Evidence and dates of 2 Varicella vaccines <u>or</u> a positive titer; must submit copy of result.
Tuberculosis (TB) Screening	The School of Nursing currently requires annual TB testing for all students. Students must have TB screening done within 6 months prior to matriculation. You can get one of the three items completed for TB: • QuantiFERON blood draw with a negative (-) result. • Two PPD skins tests at least a week a part with negative (-) results. Please note that you need 2 separate PPD skin tests. An issued TB and a reading is equivalent to 1 PPD skin test. • One T-Spot test with a negative (-) result. -If you have ever had a positive TST or QTFG test: you will need to submit a chest X-Ray report and treatment history. You will need to complete an annual TB clearance questionnaire yearly while at OHSU. - If you had BCG vaccine, obtain QuantiFERON TB Gold blood test and submit result. If positive, consider taking latent TB therapy. You will need to complete annual TB

	clearance questionnaire while at OHSU.
COVID-19	Received both does of a 2-dose COVID-19 vaccine, or 1-dose of a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine, and that at least 14 days have passed since your final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine was issued before starting the program. The other option is to submit a COVID declination form through Enterprise Health, and adhere to Student Health's current requirements designed to minimize COVID-19 transmission. Students wishing to submit a COVID declination should do so when they receive their OHSU network login credentials (usually about 30 days before the start of their program). Students will need to let Compliance Officer know that they are completing a COVID declination.

Some vaccination requirements may be declined. You must receive counseling by the Student Health & Wellness Center, signa formal waiver with your Dean of Students and giving the waiver to JBT Health & Wellness Center for your file. For questions, please email us at soncompliance@ohsu.edu.
