The CPP program is designed for students to be able to complete all requirements plus an internship in 5 years. OHSU policy mandates Ph.D. completion within 7 years. "Students who enter a PhD program are allowed 28 consecutive terms (seven years) of continuous registration to satisfy all requirements for the doctoral degree (unless an extension is granted), during which time they are required to maintain full-time status."

Completion of a pre-matriculation drug screen as part of the background check process. OHSU has a drug testing policy for all health care related employees including clinical psychology doctoral students. Despite changes in Oregon statute regarding marijuana use and possession, OHSU will continue to adhere to Federal law and maintain a zero-tolerance policy in this regard. Test results are confidential as required by Federal and State laws. Tests are paid for by OHSU.

OHSU requires immunizations for its students in accordance with recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and from the State of Oregon. Students must comply with OHSU pre-entrance immunization requirements per Policy 03-30-150 and Policy 02-90-010, and remain in compliance for the duration of their enrollment at OHSU. and remain in compliance for the duration of their enrollment at OHSU. This means that all admitted students must provide proof of full COVID-19 immunization or receive an approved medical or religious exception 21-days prior to the start of the academic term. Admission into OHSU academic programs are considered conditional until proof of full vaccination is provided or a medical or religious exception is approved by OHSU.

OHSU guarantees coverage of tuition, fees, and health insurance (including for families) for all matriculated students, and will provide an annual stipend of \$35,803 for the 2022-2023 year for students enrolled full-time, 9 credits or more. The funds are intended to help defray living expenses and miscellaneous costs such as books and travel expenses. Students are expected to be involved in their primary mentor's research lab on a grant-related project. Student teaching is not required to obtain financial support. Stipend funding for the internship year will consist of the stipend provided by the internship. Health insurance during the clinical internship year is provided by the internship site.
