As a resident primary care physician at the VA General Medicine Clinic, you will be supported by your Patient Aligned Care Team, which includes registered nurses who are the first point of contact for acute patient issues, a mental health team embedded in our clinic, health coaches to aid patients in setting and achieving their goals, and a supervising attending who will work closely with you throughout residency to develop your skills in outpatient medicine.
