

Penetrating Injuries


OHSU Penetrating Numbers



Abstraction of 2022 and 2023 records incomplete




Penetrating Assaults

Collaboration Begins

- Early 2020
 - HHP approached OHSU Public Safety
 - Trauma Program joined the process late
- 2021 barriers identified
 - Program Champion
 - How to onboard partner program





OBSTACLES

Most can be overcome by the appropriate use of explosives.

- BARRIER Releasing PHI -without consent
- BARRIER Background Checks





- Legal, Privacy, and Risk
 - Memorandum of Understanding
 - Business AssociateAgreement

Background Check



- Credible messengers
- Engage Public Safety
- Track back ground checks for completion





- Office of Visitors and Volunteers
 - Onboard as OHSU Volunteers
 - OHSU Training standards
 - HIPPA
 - OHSU Privacy
 - OHSU ID Badge
- Tour OHSU trauma units
- Introduce HHP to our staff



HHP Consult



- Identify patients meeting consult criteria
- Place Epic Consult for HHP within 4 hours
- TNC Original Champion
 - Reviewed all cases for HHP consults
 - Follow up with team

Improved Information Sharing



- Improved information sharing
 - Microsoft Teams log
 - SW document HHP consult
 - Loop closure HHP documents services offered
 - IP Coordinator lead violence prevention work
 - Review cases and add to HHP log
 - Refer cases to HHP when missed
 - Attend HAVI conference to network and learn



Ongoing Collaboration



- Stop the Bleed training
- Increase staff awareness
- Support expansion of program to other sites
- Research



Sustainable Funding



- Identify grants that could support HHP work
 - Grants for staffing
 - Grants for Bleeding control kits
- HB 4045 established law to bill Medicaid
- Approved through CMS
 - Increasing recognition of lived experience
 - Professionalize the service
 - Billable service Medicaid reimbursement



Hospital Violence Prevention Program Grant



- OHA funding to support program expansion
 - Hospitals
 - Community Partners
- Grant writing assistance may be available
- Recipients participate in a learning community
- Additional grant funding may be available
